AND MAYPORT WATERFRONT, INC. AND 12 THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE FOR USE OF CITY-OWNED 13 PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE "MUD HOLE", LOCATED AT 14 OCEAN STREET (R.E. #168259-0000), 15 4212 JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32233; PROVIDING FOR 16 OVERSIGHT BY THE PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY 17 18 SERVICES DEPARTMENT; FINDING THAT THESE CONTRACTUAL SERVICES ARE EXEMPT FROM COMPETITIVE 19 20 SOLICITATION PURSUANT ТО SECTION 126.107 21 (EXEMPTIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), 22 ORDINANCE CODE; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY 23 PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: 25 26 Section 1. Lease Agreement Approved and Execution 27 Authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and 28 29 deliver a Lease Agreement between Florida Youth Maritime Training, Inc. and Mayport Waterfront, Inc. ("Collectively Tenant") and the 30 31 City of Jacksonville ("Landlord"), attached hereto as Exhibit 1 (the

"Lease"). Said Lease is for use of the property known as the "Mud 1 2 Hole", at 4212 Ocean Street (R.E. #168259-0000), located 3 Jacksonville, Florida 32233. The purpose of the Lease is to allow Tenant to utilize the property to bring a vocational apprenticeship 4 5 program to Mayport for training in the maritime industry, including commercial fishermen, certified boat repair technicians, deckhands 6 7 for commercial vessels and qualified engineering members certified by the U.S. Coast Guard. Mayport has areas that are economically 8 9 distressed and the desire is that by relocating the Florida Youth 10 Maritime Training School and its training vessels to the Mud Hole property, there will be increased opportunities for members of the 11 surrounding community to participate in the program. This property 12 also abuts property of the U.S. Coast Guard Station, which makes it 13 a particularly suitable location for the training program focusing 14 15 on maritime careers.

Section 2. Finding that Lease Agreement is exempt from 16 competitive solicitation under Section 126.107 (Exemptions), Chapter 17 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code. Certain contractual and 18 professional services are exempt from competitive solicitation 19 20 pursuant to Section 126.107, Ordinance Code. In this case, the Council 21 finds that the Lease Agreement falls within exemption (g): in that 22 the contractual services to be provided by those prescribed in 23 authorizing legislation. Accordingly, the Lease Agreement herein 24 approved is not subject to competitive solicitation.

25 Section 3. Oversight Department. The Parks, Recreation and 26 Community Services Department shall oversee administration of the 27 Lease described herein.

28 Section 4. Requesting emergency one cycle passage pursuant 29 to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this 30 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the 31 Florida Youth Maritime Training, Inc. is beginning a new training

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1 cycle this fall and would like to commence that class in Mayport to 2 centralize its educational and training facilities; this will allow 3 them to utilize the Mayport site as their primary location.

4 Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become
5 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
6 without the Mayor's signature.
