AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,139,658.14 (\$1,100,000.00 FROM THE TRAFFIC SIGNALIZATION -COUNTYWIDE PROJECT AND \$39,658.14 FROM THE COUNTYWIDE INTERSECTION IMP -INTERSECTION PROJECT) TO THE PROJECTS TITLED MONUMENT ROAD AT REGENCY SQUARE BOULEVARD INTERSECTION AND ITS IMPROVEMENTS, ARLINGTON ROAD AT OAKWOOD DRIVE INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AND ST. JOHNS BLUFF AT BAHIA/THERESA INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS "PROJECTS"), AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-038; 2024-2028 FIVE-YEAR AMENDING THEIMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2023-505-E TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE PROJECTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

The funding above represents an appropriation (\$1,100,000.00 \$1,139,658.14 from the Traffic Signalization - Countywide project and \$39,658.14 from the Countywide Intersection Imp - Intersection project) to provide funding for (i) the construction of the Monument Road at Regency Square Boulevard Intersection and ITS Improvements project, (ii) the engineering and design of Drive Arlington Road at Oakwood Intersection Improvements project, and (iii) the engineering and design of St. Johns Bluff at Bahia/Theresa Intersection project.

The purpose of the appropriation in Section 2. Purpose. Section 1 is to transfer funds from the Traffic Signalization -Countywide project and the Countywide Intersection Imp - Intersection project to the Monument Road at Regency Square Boulevard Intersection and ITS Improvements project, the Arlington Road at Oakwood Drive Intersection Improvements project, Johns and St. Bluff Bahia/Theresa Intersection project (the "Projects"). The Monument Road at Regency Square Boulevard Intersection and ITS Improvements project includes traffic signal improvements at the Monument Road and Regency Square intersection, improvements to the west approach including pavement marking transitions to accommodate a larger pedestrian refuge island and improve eastbound traffic, and the installation of fiber optic interconnect to connect to existing traffic signals to the north and south. The Arlington Road at Oakwood Drive Intersection Improvements project includes a traffic signal mast arm replacement and the realignment of the south Arlington Road at the Arlington Road and Oakwood approach crosswalk intersection. The St. Johns Bluff at Bahia/Theresa Intersection Improvements project includes traffic signal upgrades at intersection of St. Johns Bluff and Bahia Drive/Theresa Drive, offset of the northbound and southbound left-turn lanes, the extension of

the eastbound through/right-turn lane to create a 125-foot long lane, and installation of interconnect improvements between this intersection the intersection of St. Johns Bluff and Atlantic Boulevard.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect this appropriation of funds to the Projects as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached hereto as Exhibit 2, and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay both the commencement and completion of the Projects.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2023-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2023-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
