AN ORDINANCE REGARDING APPOINTMENTS TO CERTAIN AND COMMISSIONS OF BOARDS THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE; SECTION 77.106 AMENDING (MEMBERSHIP, ORGANIZATION AND MEETINGS), CHAPTER 77 (KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT FOUR MEMBERS OF THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE BOARD SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR AND CONFIRMED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND THREE SHALL BEAPPOINTED BY THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT AND CONFIRMED BY THE CITY COUNCIL; AMENDING SECTION 90.101 (ESTABLISHMENT; COMPOSITION; MEMBER OUALIFICATIONS; ANNUAL TRAINING REQUIREMENT; RESPONSIBILITIES), CHAPTER 90 (BOARD OF LIBRARY TRUSTEES), ORDINANCE CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT SEVEN MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF LIBRARY TRUSTEES SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR AND CONFIRMED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND FIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT AND CONFIRMED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Amending Section 77.106 (Membership, organization and meetings), Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance),

Ordinance Code. Section 77.106 (Membership, organization and

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meetings), Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 77 - KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE

Sec. 77.106. - Membership, organization and meetings.

- Membership; qualifications. The Kids Hope Alliance Board (a) shall consist of seven members four of whom shall be each appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council and three of whom shall be appointed by the Council President and confirmed by Council. The members shall be permanent residents of Duval County inclusive of Urban Service Districts 2, 3, 4 and 5.
- Term of office and appointment. Members shall serve staggered (b) four-year terms or until their qualified successors have been appointed and confirmed. No member may serve more than two consecutive terms. Of the seven persons selected to initially serve on the Board, two members shall serve initial terms of two years and two members shall serve initial terms of three years.
- Removal. Members appointed by the Mayor may be removed or (C) replaced by the Mayor at any time, with or without cause, with a two-thirds vote of the Council. Members appointed by the Council President may be removed or replaced by the Council President at any time, with or without cause, with a two-thirds vote of the Council.

Section 2. Amending Section 90.101 (Establishment; Composition; Member Oualifications; Terms; Annual Training Responsibilities), Chapter 90 (Board of Requirement; Trustees), Ordinance Code. Section 90.101 (Establishment; Qualifications; Terms; Composition; Member Annual Training Requirement; Responsibilities), Chapter 90 (Board of Library

Trustees), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 90.101. - Establishment; Composition; Member Qualifications; Terms; Annual Training Requirement; Responsibilities).

There is hereby established a board to be known as the Board of Library Trustees (the "Board") to provide free library service for the use and enjoyment of the citizens of the Consolidated Government.

(a) Composition. The Board shall consist of 12 members, 2 members shall be appointed from (reside in) each of the five City Council At-Large Groups, and two members shall be appointed At-Large. The Mayor shall appoint one member from each of the five City Council At-Large Groups and the two At-Large members. The Council President shall appoint one member from each of the five City Council At-Large Groups. At least 11 of the 12 voting members shall be citizens and residents of the County, and one At-Large voting member may be a non-resident provided that said member works in the City and is a patron of the Library. All appointments to the Board members—shall be appointed by the Mayor and—subject to confirmation by the City Council.

Section 3. Codification Instructions. The Codifier and the Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and division "table of contents" consistent with the changes set forth herein. Such editorial changes and any other changes necessary to make the Ordinance Code consistent with the intent of this legislation are approved and directed herein, and the changes to the Ordinance Code shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
