7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$354,821.00 FROM
8 THE JACKSONVILLE TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY TO
9 FUND THE ASSIGNMENT OF TWO FULL TIME OFFICERS
10 OF THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE (JSO) TO
11 THE JACKSONVILLE REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION
12 CENTER AT LAVILLA, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 20-
13 083; PROVIDING FOR A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS INTO
14 THE 2020-2021 FISCAL YEAR; APPROVING AND
15 AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF TO EXECUTE THE
16 MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN JACKSONVILLE
17 TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY AND JACKSONVILLE
18 SHERIFF'S OFFICE; APPROVING POSITIONS, AS
19 INITIATED BY R.C. 20-127; PROVIDING FOR AN
20 EFFECTIVE DATE.

22 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
24 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the
25 indicated sum from the account listed in subsection (a) to the
26 account listed in subsection (b):

3 (c) Explanation of Appropriation.

4 The funding above is a transfer from the Jacksonville
5 Transportation Authority to the General Fund/SH/IHHS/Task
6 Force Operations account to cover the costs of the
7 assignment of two full time officers of the Jacksonville
8 Sheriff's Office (JSO) to the Jacksonville Regional
9 Transportation Center at Lavilla.

10 **Section 2. Purpose.** JSO and the Jacksonville
11 Transportation Authority (JTA) have entered into a Memorandum of
12 Agreement (MOA) for the assignment of two full time JSO officers to
13 the Jacksonville Regional Transportation Center at Lavilla. The
14 purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funds for
15 the costs of the assignments.

16 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in Section 1
17 of this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into fiscal
18 year 2020-2021.

19 **Section 4. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby
20 approved, and the Jacksonville Sheriff is authorized to execute on
21 behalf of the City, the Memorandum of Agreement between
22 Jacksonville Transportation Authority and Jacksonville Sheriff's
23 Office, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**.

24 **Section 5. Approval of Positions.** There are hereby
25 approved the positions more fully described in R.C. 20-127,
26 attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein by this
27 reference. Upon termination of the Memorandum of Agreement between
28 the Jacksonville Transportation Authority and the Jacksonville
29 Sheriff's office, the positions more fully described in R.C. 20-127
30 shall be eliminated.

31 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become

1 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
2 without the Mayor's signature.
