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15 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

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17 **Section 1. Amending Title III (Executive Branch), Chapter**
18 **30 (Planning and Development Department), Part 1 (Organization),**
19 **Sections 30.101 (Establishment; Director of the Planning and**
20 **Development Department), 30.103 (Definitions) and 30.104**
21 **(Functions), Ordinance Code.** Chapter 30 (PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT
22 DEPARTMENT), Part 1 (Organization), is hereby amended to read as
23 follows:

24 **CHAPTER 30. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT.**

26 **PART 1. ORGANIZATION**

28 **Sec. 30.101. - Establishment; Director of the Planning and**
29 **Development Department.**

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1 In this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:

2 ~~(a)~~ *City* means the City of Jacksonville, excluding the
3 Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Urban Services Districts,
4 except as to county planning functions.

5 ~~(b)~~ *General location* means area or neighborhood to be served,
6 but not site specific.

7 ~~(c)~~ *Long-range plans* means plans which define needs from five
8 years to ten years.

9 *Resiliency Strategy* means the plan developed by the City for
10 creating the projects, programs, funding, management, and
11 implementation goals for a resilient Jacksonville.

12 ~~(d)~~ *Short-range plans* mean plans, which define needs for
13 three to five years.

14 **Sec. 30.104. - Functions.**

15 The Department shall:

16 (a) Conduct research studies, collect, compile and analyze
17 socioeconomic data and prepare maps, charts and tables
18 necessary for the accomplishment of its other functions
19 and for use by governmental and private entities.

21 (z) Coordinate with the Downtown Investment Authority Chief
22 Executive Officer regarding planning, permitting and
23 development Downtown. Such areas shall include, but not
24 be limited to, the Historic Preservation Section,
25 Development Services, Development of Regional Impact
26 Coordinator, and the Bicycle/Pedestrian Coordinator.

27 (aa) Coordinate, develop, refine, and integrate the resilience
28 policies and practices for the City.

29 (bb) Develop and coordinate the City's Resiliency Strategy
30 across all departments.

1 at the pleasure of the Mayor. The CRO shall serve as the chief
2 liaison for all City operations relating to resiliency and shall be
3 responsible to the Director for the development and coordination of
4 Jacksonville's Resiliency Strategy across all departments. The CRO
5 shall meet the following qualifications:

6 (a) Required Education: a master's degree or higher, from
7 an accredited college or university, in engineering,
8 environmental sciences, biology, sustainability,
9 planning, or a closely related field.

10 (b) Required Experience: Four years of progressively
11 responsible professional work experience in
12 sustainability planning, resiliency planning, or a
13 related field.

14 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
15 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
16 without the Mayor's signature.
