11 LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL FOR THE CITY COUNCIL ON THE  
12 ISSUES OF REDISTRICTING LITIGATION AND  
13 LEGISLATIVE REDISTRICTING PROCESS; PROVIDING  
14 FOR A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS INTO THE 2023-2024

17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,  
19 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated

6 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of this appropriation is to  
7 provide up to \$1,000,000.00 of funding for the purpose of possible  
8 future procurement of special legislative counsel for the City Council  
9 on the issues of the pending redistricting litigation and the  
10 legislative redistricting process, pursuant to Chapter 14 and Section  
11 108.505, *Ordinance Code*.

12 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in Section 1 of  
13 this ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into fiscal year  
14 2023-2024.

15 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
16 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
17 without the Mayor's signature.
