ORDINANCE 2023-610

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED BY ORDINANCE 2021-382-E AND SUBSEQUENTLY RE-APPROPRIATED AND CARRIED OVER IN ORDINANCE 2022-93-E; APPROVING, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AN AMENDMENT TO THE GRANT AGREEMENT FOR HISTORIC STANTON SCHOOL BUILDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND HISTORIC STANTON, INC. EXTEND THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT TO EXPIRE ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2024; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION; CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; REQUESTING ONE PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2021-382-E appropriated \$300,000 to a designated contingency account for Historic Stanton, Inc. to be used for building improvements at the historic Stanton School located at 521 West Ashley Street in downtown Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2022-93-E subsequently appropriated \$156,290 from the contingency account created by Ordinance 2021-382-E and authorized execution of a Grant Agreement for Historic Stanton School Building between the City of Jacksonville and Historic Stanton, Inc. (the "Grant Agreement"), providing the terms and conditions for expenditure of City funds for completion of improvements to the Historic Stanton School for a term expiring on September 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2022-93-E also authorized the carryover of the remaining \$143,710 appropriated by Ordinance 2021-382-E for improvements to the school to September 30, 2023, and these funds currently remain in the contingency account; and

WHEREAS, as of August 22, 2023, \$100,000 has been distributed to Historic Stanton, Inc. through the Grant Agreement with \$56,290 remaining; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to extend the term of the Grant Agreement to September 30, 2024, and to authorize the carryover of the funds remaining in the Historic Stanton contingency account through September 30, 2024; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Carryover. The funding originally appropriated by Ordinance 2021-382-E and subsequently carried over into the 2022-2023 fiscal year by Ordinance 2022-93-E is hereby carried over until September 30, 2024, to remain available to Historic Stanton, Inc. for completion of improvements to the Historic Stanton School in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement. Funding in the amount of \$56,290 will remain in its current 1Cloud account available for payment to Historic Stanton, Inc. upon successful completion of required Grant Agreement terms. The remaining \$143,710 will remain in the Historic Stanton contingency account for future appropriation.

Amendment to Grant Agreement. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, an amendment to the Grant Agreement to extend the term to September 30, 2024, with all other terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement remaining unchanged.

Section 3. Oversight. The Grants and Contract Compliance Division of the Department of Finance and Administration shall oversee

the Grant Agreement described herein.

Section 4. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the funding described herein will lapse to the General Fund Fund Balance on September 30, 2023, and the Council desires the funding remaining available for improvements to the Historic Stanton School.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
