AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$25,000 FROM GENERAL FUND OPERATING RESERVES TO THE GENERAL FUND OPERATING, MISCELLANEOUS GRANTS AND AIDS ACCOUNT, TO PROVIDE CITY GRANT FUNDING TO THE DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. MEMORIAL FOUNDATION, INCORPORATED ("MLK FOUNDATION") TO SUPPORT THE 2025 MLK HOLIDAY GRAND PARADE EVENT AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.108(G) (EXEMPTIONS FROM COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS; ETHICS AND TRANSPARENCY IN PUBLIC CONTRACTING), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH MLK FOUNDATION; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT MLK FOUNDATION; WAIVING SECTION 118.301(A)(3)(IV) (EXPENDITURE OF APPROPRIATED FUNDS), PART 3 (ADMINISTRATION OF CITY GRANTS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW THE GRANT FUNDS TO BE EXPENDED FOR COSTS OF AMUSEMENTS, SOCIAL ACTIVITIES AND INCIDENTAL COSTS RELATING THERETO; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. MEMORIAL FOUNDATION, INCORPORATED FOR THE 2025 MLK HOLIDAY GRAND PARADE; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, Section 1. within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(C) Explanation of Appropriation:

> The funding above is an appropriation of \$25,000 from General Fund Operating Reserves to the General Fund Operating, Miscellaneous Grants and Aids account to provide a grant to The Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Foundation, Incorporated ("MLK Foundation") to provide City funds for certain costs and expenses related to the 2025 MLK Holiday Grand Parade in Jacksonville. Although the funds appropriated herein are from General Fund Operating Reserves, the proposed use of these funds to

support programs and initiatives in Council District 9 fulfills the intent for funds previously appropriated in fiscal year 2023-2024 for Council District 9 Council Member strategic initiatives that were unencumbered and swept into the General Fund Operating Reserves on October 1, 2024.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide grant funds from the City of Jacksonville to MLK Foundation for the 2025 MLK Holiday Grand Parade as described in Exhibit 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. This will be the 44th year of this event which will be held in downtown Jacksonville on Monday, January 20, 2025. The City funds will offset a portion of the costs of professional fees and services for the Parade event including, but not limited to, equipment and facility rentals, advertising, security, insurance, and post-event cleanup. In addition to the City providing funds to support the parade event as described herein, the Office of Sports and Entertainment will provide assistance to MLK Foundation in the preparation and implementation of the 2025 MLK Holiday Grand Parade as determined appropriate by the City's Sports and Entertainment Officer.

Section 3. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.108(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to directly procure the professional services of The Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Foundation, Incorporated for coordination of the 2025 MLK Holiday Grand Parade as described herein. Pursuant to Section 126.108(g) (Exemptions from competitive solicitation), Part 1 (General Regulations; Ethics and Transparency in Public Contracting), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

 Section 4. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code. The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with MLK Foundation. This waiver is justified because MLK Foundation has coordinated the MLK Holiday Grand Parade and MLK Day festivities in Jacksonville for a number of years. This event honors the memory and legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., one of the most important historical figures of the 20th century. The Parade and MLK Day festivities are held annually as a means to promote and further the ideals and philosophy of this internationally renowned leader.

Section 5. Waiver of Section 118.301(a)(3)(iv), Ordinance Code. The provisions of Section 118.301(a)(3)(iv) (Expenditure of Appropriated Funds), Part 3 (Administration of City Grants), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to authorize use of the City funds appropriated herein to be expended for costs of amusements, social activities and incidental costs relating thereto, such as meals, beverages, lodging, rentals, transportation and gratuities. This waiver is justified because the City funds will be expended to support the MLK Holiday Grand Parade which is a form of amusement and social activity that has become an important tradition in Jacksonville to bring the community together to honor the legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

Section 6. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City a grant agreement with The Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Foundation, Incorporated in an amount not-to-exceed \$25,000, subject to the Term Sheet and Budget more particularly described in Exhibit 2, for a term commencing on October 1, 2024 through September

30, 2025, and all other contracts and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, Ordinance Code.

Section 7. Oversight Department. The Grants and Contract Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall oversee the grant described herein.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
