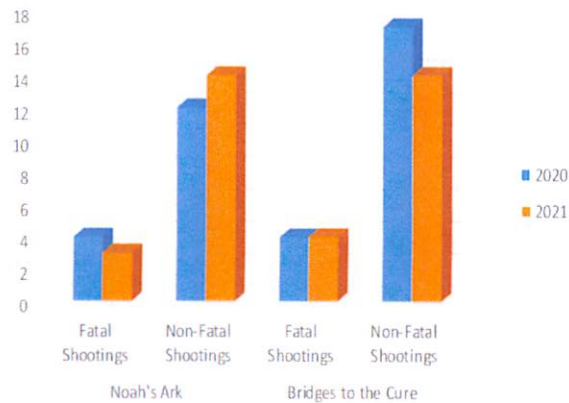

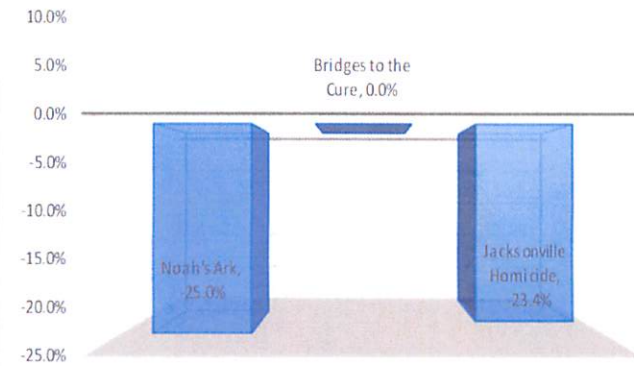

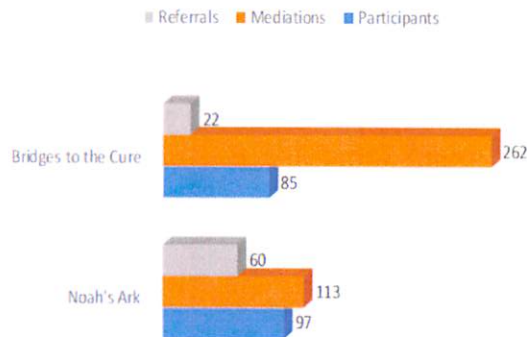
Fatal and Non-Fatal Shootings, 2020 - 2021



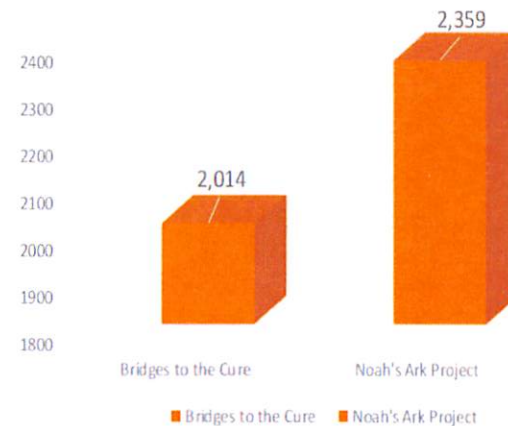
Percentage Change 2020-2021 in Homicides



Total Number of Referrals, Mediations, and Participants, 2020-2021



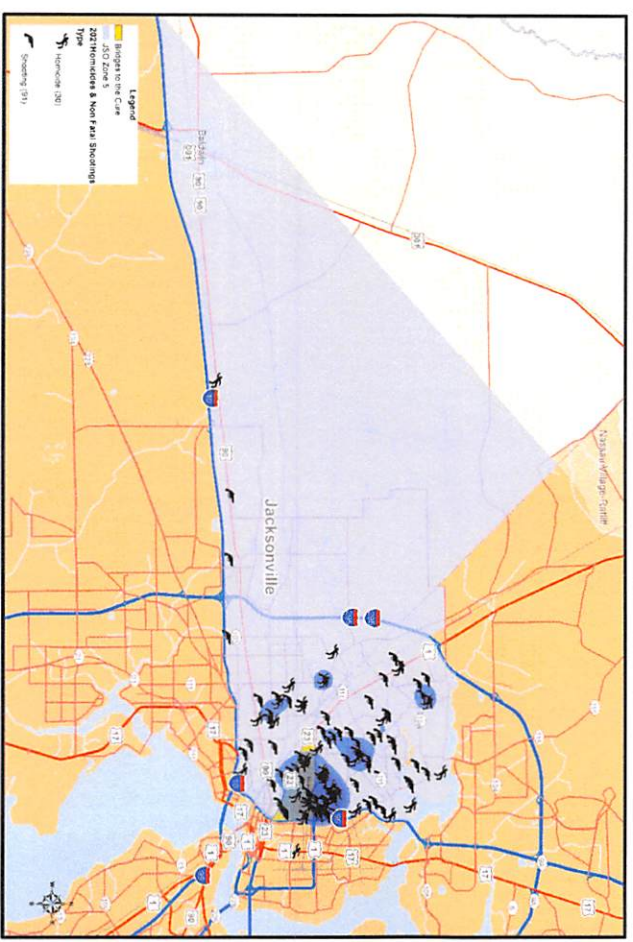
Mediation Hours, 2021, by Site



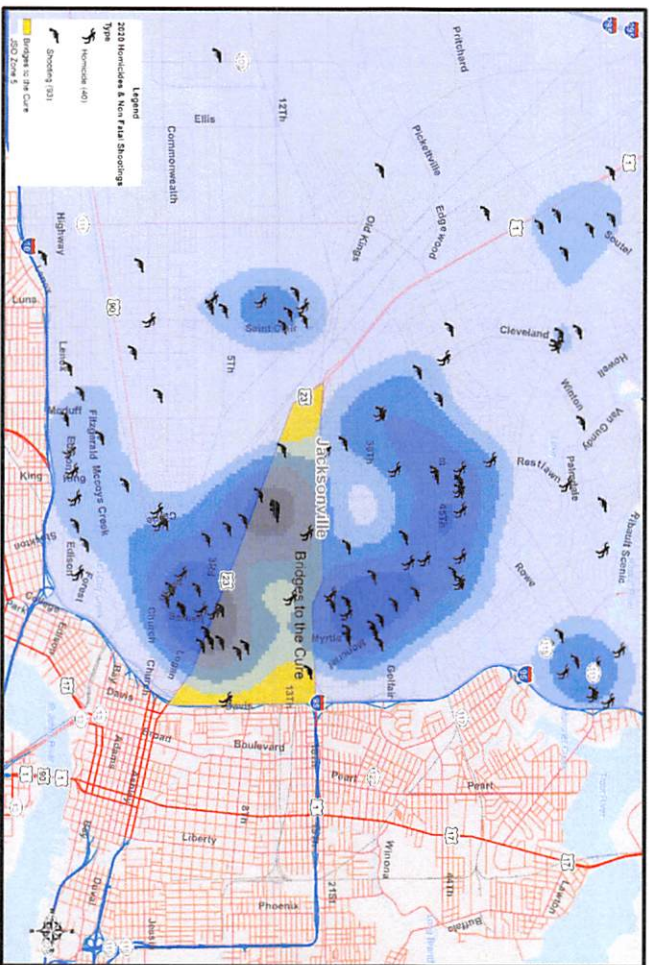

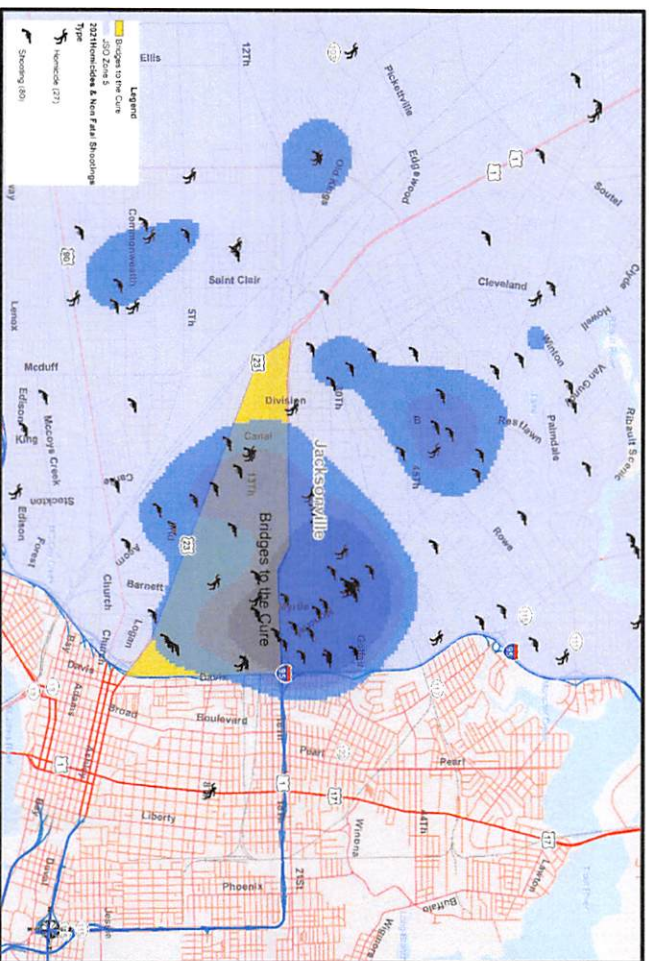


Jacksonville Homicides and Non-Fatal Shootings Hotspots in Cure Violence Areas and JSO Zone 5, 2020 - Downtown Focus



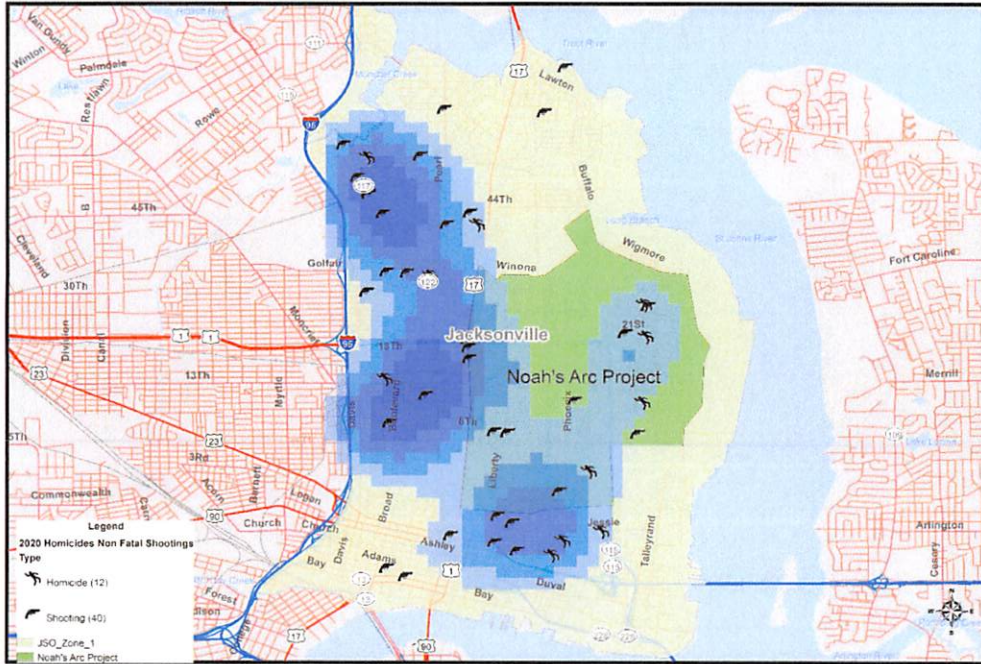

Jacksonville Homicides and Non-Fatal Shootings Hotspots in Cure Violence Areas and JSO Zone 5, 2021, Downtown Focus



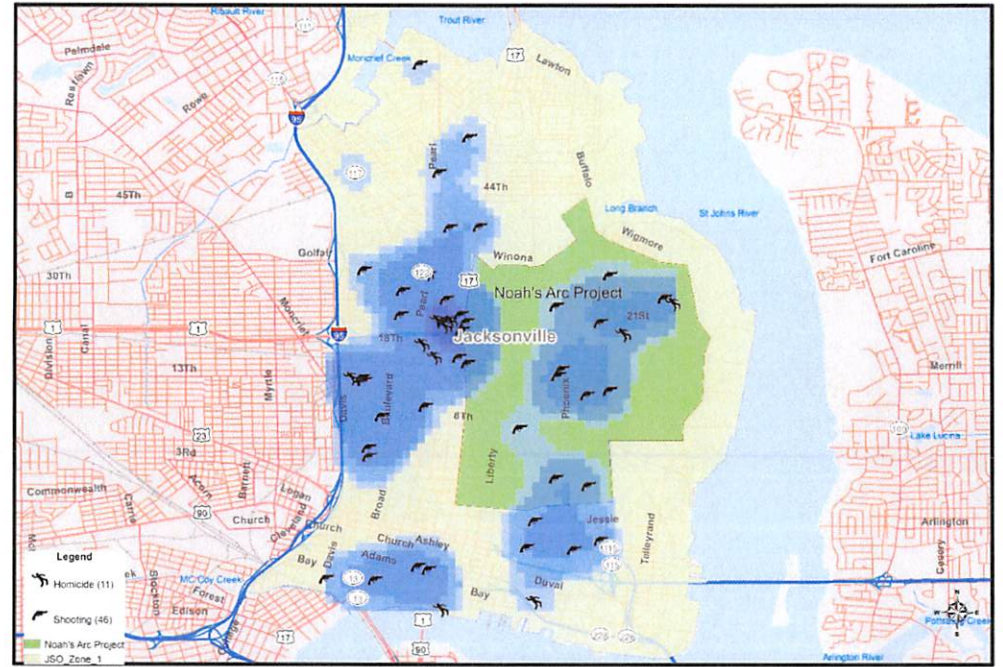
