23 provided insigntful coverage of the city's most significant sports 24 stories, including the formation and development of the Jacksonville 25 Jaguars, landmark collegiate and high school championships, and 26 memorable community sports events, greatly enriching the local sports 27 culture; and

WHEREAS, Gene Frenette became widely respected for his commitment to journalistic integrity, professionalism, and his profound ability to capture the human spirit within sports, earning the admiration of readers, athletes, coaches, and colleagues alike; and

2 WHEREAS, Mr. Frenette's contributions extended beyond writing, 3 as he served as a mentor and role model to numerous young journalists, 4 sharing his expertise and instilling in them a commitment to 5 excellence and ethical journalism; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Frenette's dedication to his craft was 7 significantly supported by his wife of 34 years, Dot Frenette, whose 8 encouragement and partnership provided a foundation throughout his 9 long and impactful career, reflecting a deep personal commitment to 10 family and community; and

11 WHEREAS, the warmth, humor, and genuine care Mr. Frenette 12 exhibited in both his professional and personal interactions endeared 13 him greatly to the Jacksonville community, establishing him as not 14 only an iconic sports journalist but also a cherished member of the 15 community; and

WHEREAS, upon his retirement in May 2025, Gene Frenette leaves a lasting legacy of excellence in journalism and dedicated public service, having earned a permanent and cherished place in the fabric of Jacksonville's sports history and setting a benchmark for future generations; now therefore
