5 **RESOLUTION 2026-69-A**

6 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT'S  
7 APPOINTMENT OF CHERYL CROFT, A DUVAL COUNTY  
8 RESIDENT, AS A SUPERVISOR MEMBER OF THE FIVE  
9 POINTS DEPENDENT SPECIAL DISTRICT BOARD OF  
10 SUPERVISORS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CHARTER OF  
11 THE FIVE POINTS DEPENDENT SPECIAL DISTRICT,  
12 ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE 2025-539-E, FOR AN  
13 INITIAL TWO-YEAR TERM EXPIRING JUNE 30, 2028;  
14 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 **WHEREAS**, Section 189.02, *Florida Statutes*, provides that the  
17 City Council may create dependent special districts for the purpose  
18 of delivering essential services to specific areas within the City;  
19 and

20 **WHEREAS** on October 28, 2025, the City Council enacted Ordinance  
21 2025-539-E creating the Five Points Dependent Special District (the  
22 "District") and establishing the Charter of the District, which was  
23 created to provide continuing services that include, but are not  
24 limited to, the provision of elevated levels of security, landscaping  
25 and promotion within the geographic boundaries of the District; and

26 **WHEREAS**, the District's Charter established the Board of  
27 Supervisors as the District's governing body, comprised of five  
28 Supervisors and three Alternates, each appointed to serve two-year  
29 terms; and

30 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 6(b) of the District Charter, three  
31 Supervisors and two Alternates shall be appointed by the Council

1 President and confirmed by the City Council, and two Supervisors and  
2 one Alternate shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the  
3 City Council; now therefore

4 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

5 **Section 1. Confirmation of Appointment.** The Council hereby  
6 confirms the Council President's appointment of Cheryl Croft, a Duval  
7 County resident, as a Supervisor member of the Five Points Dependent  
8 Special District Board of Supervisors in accordance with the Charter  
9 of the Five Points Dependent Special District, for an initial two-  
10 year term expiring June 30, 2028.

11 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become  
12 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
13 without the Mayor's signature.
