5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$100,000.00 IN GRANT
6 FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
7 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ("FDEP") TO PROVIDE
8 FUNDING FOR THE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE
9 FACILITY PROJECT (THE "PROJECT") AS INITIATED BY
10 B.T. 26-010; AMENDING THE 2026-2030 FIVE-YEAR
11 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE
12 2025-505-E TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF
13 FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT
14 OF PUBLIC WORKS, ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION
15 MANAGEMENT DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
16 DATE.
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18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2025-2026 fiscal year,
20 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
22 listed in subsection (b):

29 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

30 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant
31 funds in the amount of \$100,000.00 from the State of

1 Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("FDEP")
2 for the Household Hazardous Waste Facility project (the
3 "Project"). The required local match in the amount of
4 \$33,000.00 has been met through previous Capital
5 Improvement Plan appropriations.

6 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
7 Section 1 is to receive and allocate FDEP's funding for the Project
8 which consists of renovations to and expansion of the existing
9 hazardous waste facility to keep up with current growth and needs and
10 addresses safety and compliance needs for hazardous storage and
11 disposal. The State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection
12 Standard Grant Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the
13 State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (Agreement
14 Number: HW607) has been placed **On File** with the Legislative Services
15 Division. The term of the grant commenced on July 1, 2025 and ends
16 on June 30, 2026.

17 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance
18 2025-505-E, adopting the 2026-2030 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
19 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
20 hereby amended to reflect this appropriation of funds to the Project,
21 as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached
22 hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. The
23 City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP
24 until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to
25 the best interests of the community because such deferral will
26 unnecessarily delay completion of the Project and receipt of grant
27 funds.

28 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
29 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
30 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP
31 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute

1 an amendment to Ordinance 2025-505-E. In all other respects, the
2 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2025-505-E
3 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

4 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Department of Public Works,
5 Engineering and Construction Management Division, shall oversee
6 Project, including administration of the Project, the grant and the
7 agreement described herein.

8 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
9 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
10 without the Mayor's signature.
