Bill Summary: The bill appropriates \$278,664 from the Tax Collector Current and Delinquent Taxes - Tax Redemption Fees – Tax Sale account to the Tax Collector General Operations - Office Equipment account to provide funding for the replacement of 6 coin and currency recycling/verification machines at Tax Collector facilities. The funds are authorized to carry-over to FY24-25.

Background Information: The Duval County Tax Collector has six (6) coin and currency recycling/verification machines which have been used extensively on a daily basis for the last eight years which must be replaced. Additional revenue collected this current year for the Tax Certificate Sale can be appropriated to fund these necessary replacements. There is an on-going maintenance cost which is already included in the Tax Collector's annual budget.

Policy Impact Area: Tax Collector operations

Fiscal Impact: The bill appropriates \$278,664 from the Tax Collector's revenues for the purchase.
