7 AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING A CONTINUATION GRANT;  
8 PROVIDING FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY  
9 DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM;  
10 APPROPRIATING \$8,561,309.00 (\$6,289,951.00 IN  
11 CDBG PROGRAM FUNDING, \$1,121,358.00 IN PROGRAM  
12 INCOME, AND \$1,150,000.00 IN REPROGRAMMED  
13 FUNDS) FOR PROGRAM COSTS, AS INITIATED BY  
14 REVISED B.T. 20-004; PROVIDING FOR THE AWARD,  
15 AUTHORIZATION, AND FUNDING, AND FOR THE CITY  
16 OF JACKSONVILLE TO EXECUTE FEDERAL PROGRAM  
17 CONTRACTS FOR CDBG PROGRAM FUNDS, AS  
18 APPLICABLE, TO IMPLEMENT REVISED B.T. 20-004;  
19 PROVIDING FOR PURPOSE; PROVIDING FOR FURTHER  
20 COUNCIL ACTION IF REVENUE DIFFERS; PROVIDING  
21 FOR THE MAYOR AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO  
22 EXECUTE AND DELIVER DOCUMENTS RELATING TO THE  
23 AWARDS; APPROVING POSITIONS, AS INITIATED BY  
24 R.C. 20-003; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

26 **WHEREAS**, the United States Department of Housing and Urban  
27 Development awards to local governments Community Development Block  
28 Grant ("CDBG") Program funds, and the local government may further  
29 award the CDBG funds to recipient organizations to implement the  
30 CDBG program; and

1           **WHEREAS**, the purpose of CDBG is to provide activities that  
2 develop viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a  
3 suitable living environment, and by expanding economic  
4 opportunities, principally for low and moderate income persons; and

5           **WHEREAS**, the City of Jacksonville is expected to receive  
6 \$6,289,951.00 in CDBG funds from the United States Department of  
7 Housing and Urban Development on or about October 1, 2019, and  
8 these moneys require appropriation; and

9           **WHEREAS**, the City of Jacksonville has \$1,121,358.00 in CDBG  
10 program income and \$1,150,000.00 in reprogrammed funds and these  
11 moneys require appropriation; and

12           **WHEREAS**, the Jacksonville Housing and Community Development  
13 Commission (the "Commission") has been designated as the agency to  
14 provide oversight and guidance to the City of Jacksonville's  
15 Neighborhoods Department, Housing and Community Development  
16 Division, and the Commission shall make recommendations on all  
17 agreements for community development and affordable housing and  
18 related programs entered into for and on behalf of the City as set  
19 forth in Section 34.203, *Ordinance Code*; and

20           **WHEREAS**, the Commission has engaged in its 2019-2020 Universal  
21 Cycle application process and awarded contract(s) to housing  
22 providers and for community development pending receipt and  
23 appropriation of the 2019-2020 CDBG funds from the United States  
24 Department of Housing and Urban Development, according to the  
25 action taken by the Commission as set forth in the certified  
26 minutes excerpt of its March 27, 2019 regular meeting, attached  
27 hereto as **Exhibit 1**, for the appropriations and authorizations  
28 relating to affordable housing and community development requested  
29 herein; and

30           **WHEREAS**, these recommended awards for affordable housing and  
31 community development requested herein are as set forth in Revised

1 B.T. 20-004, attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as  
2 "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised B.T. 20-004, June 17, 2019 - NCSPHS",  
3 and made a part hereof; now, therefore,  
4

5 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

6 **Section 1. Appropriation.** There is hereby appropriated  
7 the sum of \$8,561,309.00 to the City of Jacksonville for award of  
8 CDBG Program funds made pursuant to the Commission's 2019-2020  
9 Universal Cycle relating to affordable housing and community  
10 development, and to other City departments as appropriate for the  
11 remaining awards, and the City of Jacksonville is authorized to  
12 enter into federal program contracts as appropriate and expend  
13 those funds in accordance with awards identified in Revised B.T.  
14 20-004. The sum of \$8,561,309.00 is hereby appropriated from the  
15 indicated sums in the accounts listed in subsection (a) to the  
16 accounts listed in subsection (b) of Revised B.T. 20-004, attached  
17 hereto and made a part hereof:

22 (c) Explanation of Appropriation.

23 The funding above is federal income received from the  
24 United States Department of Housing and Urban Development  
25 (\$6,289,951.00 in CDBG program funding, \$1,121,358.00 in  
26 program income, and \$1,150,000.00 in reprogrammed funds).

27 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation set  
28 forth in Section 1 above is to expend the 2019-2020 available  
29 federal income received from the United States Department of  
30 Housing and Urban Development, and award the federal contracts (as  
31 appropriate) for the CDBG program and funding to organizations and

1 the amounts, all as set forth in Revised B.T. 20-004. A copy of the  
2 Schedule of Proposed Funding is attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit**  
3 **3**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 3, Revised Schedule, June 17, 2019 -  
4 NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the  
5 grant award letter is attached hereto as **Exhibit 4**.

6 **Section 3. Further Council Action.** If the United States  
7 Department of Housing and Urban Development approves a different  
8 allocation of funds than is appropriated by this ordinance, then  
9 the Mayor shall submit a supplementary budget to City Council for  
10 approval in accordance with the actual allocation received.

11 **Section 4. Execution of Documents.** The Mayor, or his  
12 designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to  
13 execute and deliver any and all documents necessary to effectuate  
14 the purpose set forth in Section 2 above.

15 **Section 5. Authorization of Positions.** There are hereby  
16 authorized the positions more fully described in R.C. 20-003,  
17 attached hereto as **Exhibit 5** and incorporated herein by this  
18 reference.

19 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
20 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
21 without the Mayor's signature.
