AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$137,000 FROM THE SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND (THE "FUND") TO FUND VARIOUS CRIME PREVENTION AND ENFORCEMENT EXPENDITURES AND ACTIVITIES INCLUDING: (1) PROVIDING \$37,000 TO PROCURE TWO UTV VEHICLES FOR THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S ("JSO") PATROL UNITS; (2) PROVIDING \$30,000 TO PROCURE A REAL TIME CRIME CENTER WORKSTATION FOR JSO; (3) TRANSFERRING \$12,500 FROM THE FUND TO THE TEEN DRIVER SPECIAL REVENUE FUND IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 111.365, ORDINANCE CODE, TO FUND THE TEEN DRIVER CHALLENGE PROGRAM; (4) TRANSFERRING \$12,500 FROM THE FUND TO THE POLICE EXPLORERS TRUST FUND IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 111.340, ORDINANCE CODE, FUND JSO POLICE EXPLORER POST; TRANSFERRING \$25,000 FROM THE FUND TO THE FIRST COAST CRIME STOPPERS; AND (6) \$20,000 TO BE USED FOR THE HOMEWARD BOUND PROGRAM, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 24-007; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY THAT CERTAIN MISCELLANEOUS APPROPRIATIONS AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND FIRST COAST CRIME STOPPERS, INC.; WAIVING SECTION 110.112 (ADVANCE OF CITY

FUNDS; PROHIBITION AGAINST), PART 1 (THE CITY TREASURY), CHAPTER 110 (CITY TREASURY), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR ADVANCE PAYMENT TO FIRST COAST CRIME STOPPERS, INC.; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$137,000.00 in Contributions from Private Sources within the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund (the "Fund") to procure contractual services and equipment and includes transfers of Fund dollars to other City funds for various crime prevention and law enforcement expenditures and activities in accordance with the Ordinance Code and Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, as more specifically outlined herein.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide \$37,000 to procure two UTV vehicles for the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office ("JSO") patrol units and to provide

\$30,000 to procure a Real Time Crime Center Workstation for JSO. In addition, this appropriation will transfer \$12,500 from the Fund to the Teen Driver Special Revenue Fund for the Teen Driver Challenge Program in accordance with Section 111.365, Ordinance Code; transfer \$12,500 from the Fund to the Police Explorers Trust Fund for the JSO Police Explorer Post in accordance with Section 111.340, Ordinance Code; will transfer \$25,000 to First Coast Crime Stoppers; and transfer \$20,000 to the Homeward Bound Program. A Certification from the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office that the subject appropriation from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Approval and Authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City that certain Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and First Coast Crime Stoppers, Inc., in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 4. Waiving Section 110.112, Ordinance Code.

Section 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition against), Part 1

(The City Treasury), Chapter 110 (City Treasury), Ordinance Code, is hereby waived to allow for advance payment to First Coast Crime Stoppers, Inc. as provided in the Agreement.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
