**Bill Summary:** This bill appropriates \$152,362 from a General Fund Operating Special Council Contingency Account to the Council District 6 Community Study – Other Professional Services Account. The appropriation will fund a consultant to coordinate with homeowner and neighborhood associations within Council District 6 to create an entity and/or plan that fosters community engagement, builds consensus, and articulates a vision for the district with a focus on preservation and beautification. The bill ensures that the allocated funds will not lapse at the end of the fiscal year, allowing continued use into Fiscal Year 2025-2026. The Planning and Development Department will oversee the project to ensure compliance with the objectives outlined in the bill.

**Background Information:** The purpose of this legislation is to allocate funding for a community planning initiative in Council District 6. The initiative will engage a consultant to facilitate collaboration among various homeowner and neighborhood associations to develop a strategic vision for the district. The consultant will help identify priorities, create a framework for organization, and work towards enhancing the district's preservation and beautification efforts.

**Policy Impact Area:** Community planning, neighborhood development, preservation, and beautification.

**Fiscal Impact:** This bill appropriates \$152,362 from a General Fund Operating Special Council Contingency Account.

**Analyst:** Jimenez
