4 **ORDINANCE 2021-143**

5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$475,000.00 IN FUNDS
6 (A TRANSFER OF \$131,178 FROM FAIR SHARE SECTOR
7 4.2 FUNDS AND \$343,822 FROM SPECIAL EVENTS -
8 FLORIDA GEORGIA GAME CONTINGENCY) TO PROVIDE
9 FUNDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A SIDEWALK ON
10 COLLINS ROAD FROM PINEVERDE TO MATERA AVE
11 (COLLINS ROAD SIDEWALK PROJECT); AMENDING THE
12 2021-2025 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM
13 APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2020-505-E TO REDUCE
14 FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED "YACHT CLUB
15 ROAD - NEW SIDEWALK" AND PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE
16 PROJECT ENTITLED "COLLINS ROAD - NEW SIDEWALK";
17 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
21 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
22 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
23 listed in subsection (b):

30 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation**

31 The appropriation above is an appropriation of \$475,000

1 (\$131,178 of the funds above are from the Fair Share Sector
2 4.20 Funds and \$343,822 are from Special Events - Florida
3 Georgia Game Contingency) for the installation of a
4 sidewalk on Collins Road from Pineverde Lane to Matera
5 Avenue.

6 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
7 Section 1 is to provide funds for the design and construction of
8 approximately 1.2 miles of new sidewalk along Collins Road from
9 Pineverde Lane to Matera Avenue, to be known as the Collins Road
10 Sidewalk Project.

11 **Section 3. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2020-505-E, being the
12 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and
13 certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reduce the
14 funding for the project entitled "Yacht Club Road - New Sidewalk" and
15 provide funding for the project entitled "Collins Road Sidewalk - New
16 Sidewalk." The projects are more fully described in the Project
17 Information Sheets, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated
18 herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this
19 amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will
20 be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such
21 deferral will result in the unnecessary delay of the installation of
22 the sidewalk which is in the best interest of the public for public
23 safety. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
24 this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
25 Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment
26 set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an
27 amendment to Ordinance 2020-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-
28 Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2020-505-E
29 shall continue in full force and effect.

30 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
31 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective

1 without the Mayor's signature.
