Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Kimberly Corbin, as Chief of the Municipal Code Compliance Division of the Neighborhoods Department.

Background Information: Section 34.302, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the Chief of Municipal Code Compliance Division shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by the Council. The Chief shall have a bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited college or university and at least five years of experience in an administrative or management position.

Ms. Corbin holds a bachelor's degree from St. Leo University and master's degree from the University of South Florida. She serves as the property and evidence supervisor for the Gainesville Police Department, and she served previously as Code Compliance Director for the City of Destin and Code Compliance Manager for the City of Savannah.

Policy Impact Area: Neighborhoods Department operations

Fiscal Impact: The salary range for this position is \$116,866.58 - \$190,802.50 annually.
