These funds will be used to support the State Housing Initiatives Partnership ("SHIP") program. The SHIP program grant and income funds must be committed to eligible projects no later than June 30, 2027, and must be fully expended for completed projects no later than June 30, 2028.

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9 Section 2. Purpose. The Florida Housing Finance 10 Corporation provides funding to local governments as an incentive to 11 create partnerships that produce and preserve affordable 12 homeownership and multifamily housing. The SHIP program was designed to serve very low, low, and moderate-income families. SHIP funds may 13 be used for emergency repairs, new construction, rehabilitation, down 14 payment and closing costs assistance, impact fees, construction and 15 gap financing, mortgage buy-downs, acquisition of property for 16 17 affordable housing, matching dollars for federal housing grants and programs, homeownership counseling, and the Foreclosure Intervention 18 19 Program. The Schedule of Proposed Funding detailing the proposed uses 20 of the SHIP funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated 21 herein by this reference. A copy of the State of Florida Projected 22 SHIP Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 is attached hereto as Exhibit 23 3.

24 Section 3. Approval of Positions. There are hereby 25 approved the positions more fully described in R.C. 25-123, attached 26 hereto as Exhibit 4 and incorporated herein by this reference. Said 27 positions are fully funded by SHIP grant dollars and will provide 28 services in support of the SHIP program.

29 Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 30 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 31 without the Mayor's signature.
