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## RESOLUTION 2024-701

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING 7407 and 7447 SALISBURY ROAD (R.E. 152577-0020, 152577-0010, 152577-0050, 152578-0010, 152578-0000), JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA, IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 11, AS A BROWNFIELD AREA FOR ENVIRONMENTAL REHABILITATION AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; PROVIDING FOR NOTIFICATION OF A BROWNFIELD SITE REHABILITATION AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Butler Creek Owner, LLC ("Butler Creek") owns land located at 7407 Salisbury Road (R.E. 152577-0020, 152577-0010, and 152577-0050) and has the option to purchase and lease land located at 7447 Salisbury Road (R.E. 152578-0010 and 152578-0000) currently owned by Orion Investments Enterprise, LLC, Jacksonville, Florida, in Council District 11, a map is attached as Exhibit 1 (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, Orion Investments Enterprise, LLC has authorized Butler Creek to apply for Brownfield Area designation of the portion of the property that it owns; and

WHEREAS, the Property was previously used as a private solid
waste disposal facility and is impacted by solid waste and debris;
and

WHEREAS, Bulter Creek plans to conduct further assessment and remediation activities on the Property to achieve regulatory site closure from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (the "FDEP"); and

WHEREAS, Butler Creek is requesting that City Council adopt a

resolution designating the Property a Brownfield Area as authorized under the Florida Brownfields Redevelopment Act, Sections 376.77 - 376.85, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, following enactment of a resolution approving the Brownfield Area designation, Butler Creek will negotiate a Brownfield Site Rehabilitation Agreement (the "Agreement") with the FDEP; and

WHEREAS, Butler Creek is pursuing the Brownfield designation and the Agreement to benefit from the State of Florida's Voluntary Cleanup Tax Credit program and cleanup liability protection from the State; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Planning and Development Department's Community Planning Division and the Brownfield Redevelopment Program that, having met the criteria required for Brownfield Area designation, the Brownfield designation requested by Butler Creek be approved, a copy of the Staff Report is attached as Exhibit 2; and

WHEREAS, the City has complied with the procedures and has given proper notice as required by Section 376.80, Florida Statutes; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Findings. The Council, acting as the governing body of Duval County, finds the preamble hereof to be true and correct.

Section 2. Designation. For the purposes of the Florida Brownfields Redevelopment Act, Sections 376.77 - 376.85, Florida Statutes, the Property is hereby designated a Brownfield Area. For the purposes of Jacksonville's Brownfield Program, this area shall be called the "Butler Creek Green Reuse Area". This designation shall not, however, render the City of Jacksonville liable: for the cost of site rehabilitation or source removal, as those terms are defined in Sections 376.79(17) and (18), Florida Statutes; for other costs

in excess of those attributable to the City as administrator of a Brownfield Program; or as a property owner, if the City hereafter acquires any realty within the designated Brownfield Area.

Section 3. Notification of Rehabilitation Agreement.

Butler Creek will negotiate a Brownfield Site Rehabilitation

Agreement with the FDEP and notify the City Brownfield Coordinator when such an agreement has been reached.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
