Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Elizabeth Heuer as a member of the Art in Public Places Committee, as an art professional, replacing Keith Doles, for a partial term to expire on December 31, 2022, followed by a first full term to expire on December 31, 2025.

Background Information: The Art in Public Places Committee is established pursuant to Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, and charged to choose art which is compatible with and which will enhance the architecture and general environment of the City; receive, review and act on the recommendations of the Art Selection Panels; seek to ensure that at least $15 \%$ of the artists selected for purchase or commission will be resident(s) in the Greater Jacksonville area (Duval, St. Johns, Nassau, Clay and Baker Counties); and also encourage the selection of regional artists e.g. Florida and the Southeastern United States.

Section 126.903, Ordinance Code, provides that the eleven members of the committee are appointed by the Mayor, with three of the members from the professions of architecture, interior design, landscape architecture, planning, art professional, or art historian.

Ms. Heuer is an Associate Professor, Department of Art, Art History, and Design at the University of North Florida. Ms. Heuer has a Ph.D. in Art History from Florida State University. Ms. Heuer resides in Duval County.
