Bill Summary: The legislation approves the appropriation of \$7,298,669.56 in Community Development Block Grant program grant funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) to the City of Jacksonville for distribution to various award subrecipients selected pursuant to the Commission’s 2022-2023 Universal Cycle for community development and affordable housing initiatives and related programs and services, and to other City departments as appropriate for the remaining awards.

Background Information: The United States Department of Housing and Urban Development annually awards Community Development Block Grant (“CDBG”) funds to local governments on a formula basis that the local government may, in turn, award to qualified organizations to implement the CDBG program. The Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission is designated as the agency responsible for making recommendations to the Housing and Community Development Division on all CDBG grant funding awards made to qualified subrecipients for community development and affordable housing initiatives and related programs and services.

The City of Jacksonville is expected to receive \$7,298,669.56 in CDBG funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development on or about October 1, 2022.
