5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$150,000.00 IN GRANT  
6 FUNDING FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW  
7 ENFORCEMENT, THROUGH ITS FY 23-24 STATE  
8 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR FENTANYL ERADICATION  
9 (S.A.F.E.) IN FLORIDA PROGRAM, TO THE PSBU  
10 GRANTS/FENTANYL OVERDOSE DEATH INVESTIGATIONS  
11 (FODI) PROJECT FY 23-24 TO COMBAT ILLEGAL  
12 FENTANYL ACTIVITY, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-050;  
13 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE  
14 SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

17 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,  
18 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
19 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
20 listed in subsection (b):

28 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant  
29 funds from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement,  
30 through its FY 23-24 State Financial Assistance for  
31 Fentanyl Eradication (S.A.F.E.) in Florida Program, to the

1 Jacksonville Sheriff's Office PSBU Grants/Fentanyl  
2 Overdose Death Investigations (FODI) Project FY 23-24 to  
3 combat illegal fentanyl activity. The grant period  
4 commenced on July 1, 2023 and continues through June 30,  
5 2024. No local match is required.

6 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
7 Section 1 is to utilize the Fentanyl Overdose Death Investigations  
8 (FODI) grant funding from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement  
9 through its FY 23-24 State Financial Assistance for Fentanyl  
10 Eradication (S.A.F.E.) in Florida Program, to conduct investigations  
11 designed to combat illegal fentanyl activity and will cover expenses  
12 related to overtime for such investigations. A copy of the Grant  
13 Award outlining the terms and conditions relative to the grant and  
14 use of the grant funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and  
15 incorporated herein by this reference.

16 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office  
17 shall oversee administration of the grant and project described  
18 herein.

19 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
20 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
21 without the Mayor's signature.
