A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING SWISHER (FORMERLY SWISHER INTERNATIONAL INC.) ON ITS 100 YEARS IN JACKSONVILLE AND 162^{ND} YEAR OF OVERALL OPERATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Swisher, a family-owned company established in 1861, relocated its corporate and manufacturing headquarters from Newark, Ohio, to Jacksonville's Springfield neighborhood in 1924, creating what would become the world's largest cigar manufacturing facility under one roof by 1941; and

WHEREAS, over the past century, Swisher is credited with transforming the cigar industry with innovative manufacturing techniques including the introduction of "fresh work" cigar rolling machines in 1924 and the first individually cellophane-wrapped cigars; and

WHEREAS, Swisher was the first company in the nation to establish an industrial children's nursery in 1939, providing full-service childcare for its employees; and

WHEREAS, the company's more than 6,000 employees across Swisher's global footprint that includes the U.S., the Dominican Republic and Nicaragua embody the company's core values of staying curious, workplace inclusion, embracing risks, excellence always, and being team focused in all that they do; and

WHEREAS, Swisher's commitment to innovation with respect to proprietary manufacturing techniques, product quality, and customer satisfaction has established the company as a leader in its industry. Swisher Sweets Cigars, first introduced in 1958, remains the number

one selling cigar by volume in the world, and Drew Estate, which produces the ACID brand of handcrafted, infused premium cigars, which Swisher acquired in 2014; and

WHEREAS, Swisher remains a privately held, family-owned company operated by multiple generations of the current ownership family which acquired the company from the Swisher family in 1966. The company's leadership and employees continue to advance the company's century-plus legacy of philanthropic and civic engagement which started with the Swisher family and continues today with current ownership, through strategic partnerships and programs supporting our nation's heroes and their families, and community vitality; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City Council hereby honors and commends Swisher for its 100 years in Jacksonville and 162 years in business and for its services and commitment to the Jacksonville community. The Council extends best wishes to the company and its ownership, management and employees for the very best of continued success in the years ahead.
