Type of Action: Authorization of agreement and enforcement of speed limit

Bill Summary: This bill authorizes the Traffic Control Agreement with Emerald Preserve – Sumerlin Homeowners Association, Inc., and authorizes Jacksonville Sheriff's Office to enforce the Emerald Preserve – Sumerlin Neighborhood Speed Limit of 20 MPH. The Emerald Preserve – Sumerlin Board unanimously approved the agreement at the October 24, 2024, meeting.

Background Information: The Emerald Preserve - Sumerlin community is located on Bartram Park Boulevard, south of Old St. Augustine Road and west of Interstate-95, in Bartram Park. The community includes private and/or limited access roads with a posted speed limit of a maximum of 20 miles per hour. Jacksonville Sheriff's Office is now authorized to exercise municipal traffic control jurisdiction over the private and/or limited access roads located within the boundaries of the neighborhood.

Policy Impact Area: Traffic control, Emerald Preserve - Sumerlin

Fiscal Impact: The Emerald Preserve – Sumerlin Homeowners Association, Inc. will pay the City the actual amount of any costs incurred for services requested and subsequently provided by the City which exceed the ordinary level of traffic control service.
