## ORDINANCE 2025-732-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$10,000 FROM THE SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE FUND (10901) - ESP - PRETEEN AND TEEN PROGRAMMING - SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE ORG ACCOUNT, TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO BLUE AND WHITE CHARITIES, INC. ("BWC") FOR THE YOUTH AUXILIARIES PROGRAM (THE "PROGRAM") AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER TO FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; AMENDING THE FOURTEENTH REVISED SCHEDULE M TO ORDINANCE 2024-511-E; WAIVING CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 77.111 (CONTRACTS; CONTRACT ADMINISTRATION; CARRYOVER), CHAPTER 77 (KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO EXEMPT THE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY BWC FROM COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND/OR THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE ("KHA") TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE OF JACKSONVILLE AND BLUE AND WHITE CHARITIES, INC. FOR THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY KHA; REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$10,000 from the Special Council Contingency account to the Kids Hope Alliance Fund (10901) - ESP Preteen and Teen Programming - Subsidies and Contributions to Private Org account to provide a grant to Blue and White Charities, Inc. ("BWC") for the Youth Auxiliaries Program (the "Program") as described herein.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville to BWC for the Youth Auxiliaries Program as described in Exhibit 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The Program provides support and programming for three auxiliary clubs, each tailored to a specific age group as follows: (1) the Pearlettes (ages 4 through 8 years old), the Amicettes (ages 9 through 13 years old) and the Archonettes (ages 14 through 18 years old). The Program is designed to cultivate leadership, academic excellence and community engagement by offering youth workshops and conferences that cover a range of topics including college application processes, financial aid, resume writing, financial planning and budgeting, and insight into Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics ("STEAM") programming and careers. The City funds will be used to support the workshops

and activities for each auxiliary club/age group for a total of 25 youth participants.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2025-2026.

Section 4. Amending the Fourteenth Revised Schedule M to Ordinance 2024-511-E. The Kids Hope Alliance ("KHA") fiscal year 2024-2025 budget approved by Ordinance 2024-511-E is hereby amended by substituting in place of the Fourteenth Revised Schedule M, the Fifteenth Revised Schedule M, attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and incorporated herein by this reference, to reflect the funds appropriated herein.

Section 5. Waiving Certain Requirements of Section 77.111, Ordinance Code. The City hereby waives certain requirements of Section 77.111 (Contracts; contract administration; carryover), Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), Ordinance Code, with respect to the contract with BWC and authorized by this Ordinance. Specifically, subsection 77.111(a) requires Provider Contracts for children's services provided by third parties to be competitively procured by KHA via an evaluated bid process. This waiver is needed in order to allow KHA to directly contract with Blue and White Charities, Inc. for the Youth Auxiliaries Program described in Exhibit 2.

Section 6. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary, and/or the Chief Executive Officer of KHA, are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City or KHA, an agreement with BWC in an amount not-to-exceed \$10,000. The agreement shall be subject to and administered in accordance with Chapter 77, Ordinance Code, and the terms, scope and budget more particularly described in Exhibit 2, for a term commencing on October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026, and all other contracts and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and
