Bill Summary: This bill authorizes the agreement between the City and the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP). The Office of Administrative Services, Environmental Quality Division will provide oversight. Agreement term commences on July 1, 2026, and expires on June 30, 2031, with one five (5) year renewal.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to authorize the agreement for the City to perform petroleum contamination site cleanup management services on behalf of the FDEP in the Petroleum Restoration Program, to address rehabilitation of sites contaminated by petroleum at the local level without duplication of efforts. The Petroleum Restoration Program helps ensure the clean-up of sites in Duval County, Nassau County, Baker County, and St. Johns County that are contaminated with petroleum products in order to protect drinking water supplies and mitigate health risks associated with petroleum contamination.
