6 INCLUDING AN AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT GRANT IN
7 THE AMOUNT OF \$332,229.55 AWARDED BY THE U.S.
8 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES AND
9 DISTRIBUTED BY NORTHEAST FLORIDA AREA AGENCY ON
10 AGING, INC., D/B/A ELDELSOURCE, AND A \$53,540.44
11 CITY MATCH FROM GENERAL FUND OPERATING FUND
12 BALANCE, FOR THE JACKSONVILLE SENIOR SERVICES
13 PROGRAM, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 22-102; PROVIDING
14 FOR OVERSIGHT AND REPORTING BY THE SENIOR
15 SERVICES DIVISION OF THE PARKS, RECREATION AND
16 COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN
17 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,
21 within the City’s budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
22 sum from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
23 listed in subsection (b):

30 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:
31 The funding above represents an appropriation of American

1 Rescue Plan Act grant funding from the U.S. Department of
2 Health and Human Services, distributed by Northeast Florida
3 Area Agency on Aging, Inc. d/b/a ElderSource, in the amount
4 of \$332,229.55, and an additional appropriation of
5 \$53,540.44 from General Fund Operating Fund Balance for
6 the City match, to support the Jacksonville Senior Services
7 Program (the "Program"). The grant period commences upon
8 the date of execution of the grant agreement by the last
9 party required to sign or September 1, 2021 (whichever is
10 later) and ends on September 30, 2024.

11 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
12 Section 1 is to provide funding to support the goals and objectives
13 of the Program. Program efforts include providing supportive
14 services, nutrition services, and preventive health services to
15 family caregivers giving preference to older individuals (age 60 and
16 older) with greatest economic and social need. Crisis assistance may
17 include, but is not limited to, COVID-19 vaccination outreach,
18 education, and associated services with assisting older adults get
19 vaccinations; and services that address social isolation, including
20 activities for investments in technological equipment. A copy of the
21 ElderSource Standard Contract American Rescue Plan Act (Agreement
22 Number: RP21-JSSP) and Amendment One to the agreement, providing the
23 terms and conditions relative to receipt and expenditure of the grant
24 funds, have been placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative
25 Services.

26 **Section 3. Oversight and Reporting.** The Senior Services
27 Division of the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department
28 shall oversee administration of the grant described herein.

29 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
30 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
31 without the Mayor's signature.
