6 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT'S
7 APPOINTMENT OF ANDRE GREEN, A DUVAL COUNTY
8 RESIDENT AND EMPLOYEE DESIGNATED BY AN OWNER OF
9 A BUSINESS LOCATED IN THE DISTRICT, AS A
10 SUPERVISOR MEMBER OF THE FIVE POINTS DEPENDENT
11 SPECIAL DISTRICT BOARD OF SUPERVISORS IN
12 ACCORDANCE WITH THE CHARTER OF THE FIVE POINTS
13 DEPENDENT SPECIAL DISTRICT, ESTABLISHED BY
14 ORDINANCE 2025-539-E, FOR AN INITIAL TWO-YEAR
15 TERM EXPIRING JUNE 30, 2028; PROVIDING AN
16 EFFECTIVE DATE.

18 **WHEREAS**, Section 189.02, *Florida Statutes*, provides that the
19 City Council may create dependent special districts for the purpose
20 of delivering essential services to specific areas within the City;
21 and

22 **WHEREAS** on October 28, 2025, the City Council enacted Ordinance
23 2025-539-E creating the Five Points Dependent Special District (the
24 "District") and establishing the Charter of the District, which was
25 created to provide continuing services that include, but are not
26 limited to, the provision of elevated levels of security, landscaping
27 and promotion within the geographic boundaries of the District; and

28 **WHEREAS**, the District's Charter established the Board of
29 Supervisors as the District's governing body, comprised of five
30 Supervisors and three Alternates, each appointed to serve two-year
31 terms; and

1 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 6(b) of the District Charter, three
2 Supervisors and two Alternates shall be appointed by the Council
3 President and confirmed by the City Council, and two Supervisors and
4 one Alternate shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the
5 City Council; now therefore

6 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

7 **Section 1. Confirmation of Appointment.** The Council hereby
8 confirms the Council President's appointment of Andre Green, a Duval
9 County resident and employee designated by an owner of a business
10 located in the District, as a Supervisor member of the Five Points
11 Dependent Special District Board of Supervisors in accordance with
12 the Charter of the Five Points Dependent Special District, for an
13 initial two-year term expiring June 30, 2028.

14 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
15 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
16 without the Mayor's signature.
