Bill Summary: This bill authorizes the First Amendment to the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 City Grant Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Clara White Mission, Inc. The funds appropriated pursuant to Ordinance 2023-608-E to fund the White Harvest Farms Culinary Vocational Training Program will carry-over to FY 2024-2025. The Grants and Contract Compliance Division of the Department of Finance and Administration will provide oversight.

Background Information: Ordinance 2023-608-E appropriated \$300,000 for the White Harvest Farms Culinary Vocational Training Program and approved a grant agreement between the City and Clara White Mission, Inc. set to expire on September 30, 2024. The program will provide education and training in culinary arts, food production and service, and agriculture, targeting low-income residents in north Jacksonville, individuals residing in food deserts, and homeless veterans. The purpose of this legislation is to extend the term of the agreement to February 28, 2025 to accommodate the additional time it took to fully set up the program.
