ORDINANCE 2024-159-E

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF CORETTA HILL, A ST. JOHNS COUNTY RESIDENT, AS A MEMBER OF THE CULTURAL SERVICE GRANT PROGRAM COMMITTEE, AS ONE OF THE SEVEN COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES, REPLACING WILTON PURSUANT TO SECTION 118.605, ORDINANCE CODE, FOR A FIRST FULL TERM EXPIRING DECEMBER 31, 2026; ESTABLISHING SUBSTANTIAL ECONOMIC BUSINESS INTEREST IN DUVAL COUNTY, PURSUANT TO SECTION 50.102(B) (RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT) (MEMBERS OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), PART 1 (ORGANIZATION), CHAPTER 50 (ORGANIZATION OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), ORDINANCE CODE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

whereas, pursuant to Section 118.605(a), Ordinance Code, the membership of the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee shall include one non-voting and ten voting members: a CSGP Committee chairperson (non-voting), appointed by the President of the Cultural Council Board of Directors; three other Cultural Council Board members selected by the Board President and Committee Chairperson; and seven individuals selected by the above group (Cultural Council Board President, CSGP Committee chairperson, and three selected Cultural Council Board members); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 118.605(d), Ordinance Code, all members of the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee shall be

confirmed by the City Council; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Confirmation. The Council hereby confirms the appointment of Coretta Hill, a St. Johns County resident, to the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee, replacing Wilton Blake, as one of the seven community representatives, pursuant to Section 118.605, Ordinance Code, for a first full term expiring December 31, 2026.

Economic Business Interests in Duval County. Section 50.102 (Members of Boards and Commissions), Part 1 (Organization), Chapter 50 (Organization of Boards and Commissions), Ordinance Code, requires Board and Commission members be either a Duval Country resident or individuals with substantial economic business interest or substantial philanthropic interest in Duval County. Ms. Hill has substantial economic business interests in Duval County. She is the Chief Operating Officer for United Way of Northeast Florida, and previously served as United Way Vice President of Volunteer and Community Engagement for more than a decade. United Way of Northeast Florida is in the Jessie Ball duPont Center located at 40 East Adams Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32202.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
