13 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

14 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,  
15 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
16 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
17 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

24 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

25 The funding above is from the U. S. Department of  
26 Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for the State  
27 Criminal Alien Assistance Program, with no local match.

28 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation  
29 above is to provide funding from the U. S. Department of Justice,  
30 Bureau of Justice Assistance, for the State Criminal Alien

1 Assistance Program (SCAAP). SCAAP provides federal payments to  
2 states and localities that incur correctional officer salary costs  
3 for incarcerating undocumented criminal aliens with at least one  
4 felony or two misdemeanor convictions for violations of state or  
5 local law who were incarcerated for at least four consecutive days  
6 during the reporting period. The funds may be used for correctional  
7 purposes only. The funds will be used by the City for repairs,  
8 maintenance, and specialized equipment at all three City  
9 correctional facilities and for training of corrections officers.

10 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall  
11 become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming  
12 effective without the Mayor's signature.
