Bill Summary: This bill amends Section 21.07, *Charter* and approves an amended interagency agreement. The Finance Department will provide oversight.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to amend Article 21 of the Charter as related to JEA contributions to the City, to reflect changes for the 5-year period beginning October 1, 2024 and ending September 30, 2029 (FY25 through FY29). With this amendment, the annual contribution amounts will be for fiscal year 2024-2025 - \$137,424,496; for fiscal year 2025-2026 - \$178,798,741; for fiscal year 2026-2027 - \$140,186,728; for fiscal year 2027-2028 - \$141,488,596; for fiscal year 2028-2029 - \$143,004,482.

In addition to the annual assessment, JEA pursuant to the terms of an Interagency Agreement (as amended) with the City, agreed to provide total nitrogen water quality credit to the City through and until December 31, 2033, to assist the City in meeting its Basin Management Action Plan load reduction goal.

Policy Impact Area: JEA financial contribution

Fiscal Impact: No additional funding from the City as the FY25 payment was appropriated in the FY25 budget process.
