5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$157,172, INCLUDING
6 \$117,879 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE FEDERAL
7 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY ("FEMA") THROUGH THE
8 STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY
9 MANAGEMENT UNDER THE FEMA HAZARD MITIGATION
10 GRANT PROGRAM AND \$39,293 FROM GENERAL FUND
11 OPERATING RESERVES FOR THE REQUIRED 25% CITY
12 MATCH, TO BE USED FOR INSTALLATION OF WIND
13 RESISTANT BAY DOORS AT FIVE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE
14 FIRE STATIONS, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 22-051;
15 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE
16 AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS
17 DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,
21 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
22 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
23 listed in subsection (b):

30 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

31 The funding above represents an appropriation of a \$117,879

1 grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency,
2 distributed by the Florida Department of Emergency
3 Management, and an appropriation of \$39,293 in General Fund
4 Operating Reserves for the required 25% City match. These
5 funds will be used to install wind resistant bay doors at
6 five City of Jacksonville Fire Stations. The grant period
7 commences upon execution of the Federally-Funded Subaward
8 and Grant Agreement by both parties and continues through
9 February 28, 2024.

10 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
11 Section 1 is to fund the installation of code compliant wind resistant
12 bay doors at Fire Stations #1, #9, #30, #34 and #44. These new bay
13 doors will meet the wind speed requirements in the area to prevent
14 wind damage to these Fire Stations, their apparatus and contents from
15 severe weather and other hazards. All materials utilized will provide
16 protection against 146 mile per hour winds or the wind speed
17 protection and impact requirements of the Florida Building Code at
18 the time the permits are issued. A copy of the Federally-Funded
19 Subaward Grant Agreement (Agreement Number: H0775) providing the
20 terms and conditions relative to receipt and expenditure of the grant
21 funds has been placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services.

22 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue
23 Department, Emergency Preparedness Division shall oversee the
24 retrofit project and administration of the grant described herein.

25 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
26 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
27 without the Mayor's signature.
