ORDINANCE 2025-327-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE
MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION
SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A FIRST
AMENDMENT TO THE FY 2023-2024 CITY GRANT
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND
UNITED WAY OF NORTHEAST FLORIDA, INC. (THE
"AGREEMENT"), TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE
AGREEMENT TO EXPIRE ON JUNE 30, 2025, TO EXTEND
CERTAIN OTHER RELATED DATES AND DEADLINES WITHIN
THE AGREEMENT, AND TO REVISE THE BUDGET AS
DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR CONTINUED
OVERSIGHT BY THE SOCIAL SERVICES DIVISION OF THE
PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES
DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2023-807-E appropriated \$200,000 to United
Way of Northeast Florida, Inc. ("United Way") for the 9-8-8 Crisis
Mental Health Call Center Program (the "Program") and authorized the
Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary to execute, on
behalf of the City, a grant agreement between the City and United
Way; and

WHEREAS, the term of the FY 2023-2024 City Grant Agreement
between the City of Jacksonville and United Way (the "Agreement")
dated April 1, 2024, was originally scheduled to expire on March 31,
2025; and

WHEREAS, United Way has requested an extension to the term of

1 the Agreement and further is requesting certain adjustments to the
2 approved Program term sheet and budget to reallocate City funds to
3 line-items that better support the needs of the Program; and

4 **WHEREAS,** the City Council therefore desires to extend the term
5 of the Agreement to June 30, 2025 and to amend the Agreement to make
6 the requested adjustments to the approved Program term sheet and
7 budget;

8 **WHEREAS,** because these adjustments amount to more than 10% of
9 the affected line-items, City Council approval of the changes is
10 required; now therefore

11 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

12 **Section 1. Approval and Authorization to Execute an**
13 **Amendment to Agreement.** There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or
14 her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to
15 execute and deliver a first amendment to the FY 2023-2024 City Grant
16 Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and United Way of Northeast
17 Florida, Inc. ("United Way") (City Contract #673177-24) (the
18 "Agreement"), to extend the term of the Agreement to June 30, 2025,
19 to extend related dates based on the extension to the term authorized
20 herein, and to replace the current Term Sheet and Budget with the
21 revised Term Sheet and Budget attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and
22 incorporated herein by this reference. The term of the Agreement is
23 hereby ratified and the extension authorized herein will be
24 retroactive to March 31, 2025, to ensure there is no lapse in the
25 contract term.

26 **Section 2. Oversight.** The Social Services Division of the
27 Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department shall continue
28 to have oversight of the Agreement described herein.

29 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
30 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
31 without the Mayor's signature.
