PROGRAM OVERVIEW AND SCOPE OF WORK:

- The UNF Military and Veterans Resource Center serves over 2,000 military connected students, and in addition to helping certify and manage their veterans' educational benefits, offers a center where they can meet to collaborate on class projects, study, and relax. Computers and printers are available and free for their use. We need additional technology to better support our military and veteran students, especially in work study groups. The technology requested is two interactive electronic whiteboards. The boards can connect to computers, smart phones, and other devices to display work projects, and allow multiple students to collaborate and develop research projects, presentations, and white papers. The whiteboards are Vibe S1 75" Smart Board, 75 Inch Interactive Display, 4K UHD Touch Screen All-in-One Computer for Office and Classroom with Chrome OS & Open App Ecosystem (Board and Stand). We need two of them, one in the main area of the center, and one in the private study room. The cost for each is \$6,398.00, total cost is \$12,796.
- A number of our military and veterans are disabled with mobility challenges and need transportation. Buses are provided around the edge of the campus, but buildings on campus are connected by sidewalks not navigable by motor vehicles. We are requesting a six-seat golf cart vehicle with cargo area to provide transportation assistance for disabled veterans on campus, especially from parking areas, classrooms, and dormitories, and shuttle supplies for military events and programming on campus. The cost for one golf cart is \$19,000.
- The MVRC also provides a kitchen to offer free refreshments to our military connected students while they are here. We offer coffee, tea, and other beverages, snacks, a microwave and toaster oven, a sink to wash dishes, and cabinets to store supplies. Our kitchen in the center needs to be refreshed and upgraded with new cabinets, countertop, coffee machine, water dispenser, and appliances for \$9,000.
- The SBDC Military Spouse Career Readiness Seminar, which is projected to have a total of 100 participants, is a comprehensive program designed to empower military spouses in Duval County with the knowledge, skills, and resources necessary to launch and grow successful businesses. Recognizing the unique challenges and opportunities associated with the frequent relocation inherent in military life, this seminar offers two distinct events tailored to specific needs, along with no-cost consulting services to provide ongoing support thereafter for twelve months. \$20,000.

Goals and Objectives for Career Readiness Seminars:

- 1. Equip military spouses with the entrepreneurial mindset and skills needed to navigate the challenges and capitalize on the opportunities of self-employment.
- 2. Provide specialized training and resources to address the unique needs and cultural nuances relevant to Hispanic military spouses.
- 3. Foster a supportive community and network to facilitate collaboration and mutual support among military spouse entrepreneurs.
- 4. Enhance access to capital, funding opportunities, and relevant resources to support the launch and growth of military spouse-owned businesses.

Need:

Military spouses in Duval County face significant barriers to traditional employment due to frequent relocation, unpredictable deployment schedules, and the challenges of balancing family responsibilities with career aspirations. This program directly addresses this need by providing targeted training, mentorship, and resources to help military spouses explore entrepreneurship as a viable career path, enabling them to achieve financial independence and professional fulfillment.

Funding:

This funding request is intended to cover programmatic expenses for FY 2024-2025, including labor, materials, marketing, and consulting services.

<u>Program Scope of Work:</u>

The SBDC Military Spouse Career Readiness Seminar will offer two distinct events:

- 1. Veteran Entrepreneurship Seminar:
 - o Module 1: Cultivating an Entrepreneurial Mindset
 - o Module 2: Legal and Regulatory Landscape for Small Businesses
 - o Module 3: Financial Planning and Management for Startups
 - o Module 4: Marketing, Sales, and Customer Relationship Strategies
- 2. Hispanic-Focused Entrepreneurship Seminar:
 - o Module 1: Leveraging Cultural Identity in Business
 - o Module 2: Overcoming Language and Cultural Barriers in Business
 - Module 3: Accessing Targeted Resources and Support Networks
 - Module 4: Building a Legacy: Inspiring Future Generations of Entrepreneurs

Deliverables:

- 1. Two comprehensive entrepreneurship seminars specifically designed for military spouses, considering their unique challenges and opportunities.
- 2. Culturally sensitive training materials and resources tailored to the needs of Hispanic military spouses.
- 3. Dedicated networking events and platforms for military spouse entrepreneurs to connect, collaborate, and build a supportive community.

- 4. Ongoing, individualized business coaching and mentorship through no-cost consulting services.
- 5. A comprehensive resource guide connecting participants to relevant support organizations, funding opportunities, and entrepreneurial tools.

Veteran/Military Student Entrepreneurship Pitch Competition –

Blackstone LaunchPad at UNF provides multi-disciplinary skill sets and mentoring services to help UNF students explore innovation, creativity and entrepreneurship. Blackstone LaunchPad builds professional and personal skill sets to succeed. With this funding Blackstone LaunchPad will conduct a student entrepreneurship pitch competition for 15-20 veteran and military students with the goals of:

- o Cultivating an entrepreneurial mindset for our veteran and military students
- Provide students with an experiential learning opportunity to provide creative solutions for real-world problems
- o Exposing students to processes and resources
- o Providing opportunity to work with mentors focused on entrepreneurship

To further support the entrepreneurial journey of veteran and military students, Blackstone LaunchPad will offer an 8-week cohort-based bootcamp prior to the competition. This bootcamp will provide intensive, cohort-based learning and mentorship, preparing students for the competition and equipping them with foundation business knowledge. The bootcamp objectives include:

- Skill Development: Cover essential topics like business model creation, marketing, finance, and legal aspects of entrepreneurship
- Peer Collaboration: Encourage teamwork and a sense of community within the cohort, building a support network for participants
- o Access to Mentorship: Offer regular mentorship from experienced entrepreneurs to provide guidance tailored to participants' unique background and needs
- o Final Project Preparation: Enable each student to develop a complete business plan as a capstone project, laying a strong foundation for the subsequent competition.

Cost of Competition & Bootcamp \$5,500

Space and event costs for Seminars and Pitch Competition \$4,000

PROGRAM REPORTING:

Upon completion of the grant period, Recipient shall provide the City with the results of a participant survey evaluating the effectiveness of the Program.

PROGRAM COSTS/PAYMENT TERMS:

City funds shall be expensed in accordance with the approved Program budget. Funds will be disbursed on a reimbursement basis upon the City's receipt and approval of required documentation including but not limited to paid invoices, cleared checks and bank statements.
