Type of Action: Appropriation, designation of oversight agency and emergency passage upon introduction

Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$10,000 from the Community Development Corporation Capacity Building Grants Contingency account to the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office. The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office will oversee the project. Emergency passage upon introduction is requested in order to provide funding to initiate security and traffic control services in this area as soon as possible to address immediate and ongoing safety concerns.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds to procure off-duty security and traffic control services in the commercial corridor of Park Street and King Street in Riverside. JSO off duty officers will provide security near the bars on King Street where folks are congregating after closing time, creating noise issues and public safety concerns.
