Bill Summary: This bill closes and abandons an opened and unimproved portion of the Dillon Street Way right-of-way, established in the Replat of the W. R. Thompson Sub-Division, as recorded in Plat Book 3, Page 46 of the current public records of Duval County, Florida, located in Council District 9. An easement for utilities, facilities, and access will be reserved over the closure areas is reserved for JEA. No City, State, or other agency has objected to this closure request.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to permit the Applicant, Wholesalers Property Company, who owns the adjacent property, to utilize the closure area for parking, utilities and a drive aisle.

Fiscal Impact: Applicant paid the \$2,091 closure fee and \$516 encroachment fee (\$2,607 total)
