Appointment. The Council hereby confirms the 6 Section 1. 7 Mayor's appointment of Amber J. Sahbudak, a Clay County resident, to the Public Service Grant Council, filling a seat formerly held by 8 9 Ryan Ertel, pursuant to Section 80.102 (Composition; Member 10 Qualifications; Terms; Annual Training Requirement; Responsibilities), Chapter 80 (Public Service Grant Council), 11 Ordinance Code, for a first full term to expire on December 31, 2026. 12

13 Section 2. Establishing Substantial Economic Business 14 Interest in Duval County. Section 50.102(b) (Members of boards and 15 commissions), Part 1 (Organization), Chapter 50 (Organization of Boards and Commissions), Ordinance Code, requires Board and 16 17 Commission members be either permanent residents of Duval County or to maintain substantial economic business or philanthropic interest 18 as determined by the City Council within Duval County. In this 19 20 instance, although the appointee does not reside within Duval County, 21 Ms. Sahbudak has substantial economic business interests in Duval 22 County, serving as the President and Owner of Ocean Movers Inc., located at 8601 Youngerman Court, Unit 4 in Jacksonville and as the 23 24 current General Manager of Jacksonville Quartz and Stone LLC, located 25 at 8570 Philips Highway, Unit 109 in Jacksonville.

One cycle emergency passage of this Ordinance is requested to enable the appointee to participate in member training and to participate meaningfully in the time-sensitive initial grant process which begins imminently.
