15 WHEREAS, the Special Committee on Duval DOGE (the "DOGE Committee") was created on March 17, 2025, and charged with the 16 following tasks: (1) to analyze recent growth in City Departments and 17 18 programs to identify areas for potential savings, (2) to evaluate services provided to identify areas for potential savings, (3) to 19 20 consider implementing a budget lapse while being mindful of potential 21 service impacts; and (4) other matters as identified by the DOGE 22 Committee; and

WHEREAS, in keeping with its charge, the DOGE Committee requested the Council Auditor's Office complete a review of the City's Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") to ascertain the status of the various projects outlined in the CIP; and

WHEREAS, as part of this review, the Council Auditor's Office identified projects that were marked as closed per the City's Transparency Dashboard and those without actual expenditures since prior to October 1, 2023, and worked with City Departments to determine if the projects were complete and should be "closed"; and WHEREAS, the DOGE Committee is recommending these projects be closed to an activity entitled "Council Contingency - DOGE" for future appropriation by the City Council and that transfers of any balances from the enumerated list of projects be prohibited; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Providing for Project Balances to be Closed to 6 7 the "Council Contingency - DOGE" Activity and Prohibiting Transfers Except to Said Activity. The DOGE Committee, in coordination with 8 9 the Council Auditor's Office and various City Departments, has 10 identified certain capital improvement projects as listed on Exhibit 1, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference (each 11 individually, a "Project" and collectively, the "Projects"), that are 12 able to be closed with unexpended funds remaining. In accordance with 13 the recommendation of the DOGE Committee, the City Council hereby 14 directs that any residual funding remaining in any Project be 15 transferred upon Project completion to an Activity entitled "Council 16 Contingency - DOGE" for future appropriation by the City Council. 17 Funds which originated from Discretionary Council Projects or from 18 19 the Special Council Reserve shall be returned to those accounts of 20 origin. The transfer of funds as authorized under Chapter 106, 21 Ordinance Code, from any Project is expressly prohibited except to 22 the Council Contingency - DOGE Activity, the Discretionary Council Projects, or the Special Council Reserve, as applicable. 23

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
