8 A RESOLUTION HONORING THE PUBLIC SERVICE AND
9 MOURNING THE PASSING OF BRYAN MOSIER; PROVIDING
10 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 **WHEREAS**, Bryan Douglas Mosier was born on August 16, 1971 in
13 Johnson City, Tennessee, and he made Jacksonville his home in 1994
14 after graduating from Bob Jones University with a Bachelor of Science
15 Degree in Operations Management; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Mosier worked for various financial institutions
17 and then spent eight years with Community First Credit Union before
18 starting his career in City government; and

19 **WHEREAS**, in 2008, Mr. Mosier accepted a position with the City
20 as Contract Compliance Manager for the Municipal Code Compliance
21 Division. He was steadily promoted for his excellent service, from
22 Administration Manager to Chief of Municipal Code and Compliance
23 Division, and then to Operations Director, and finally was appointed
24 to be the Director of the Neighborhoods Department in 2019; and

25 **WHEREAS**, as Neighborhoods Director, Mr. Mosier deftly managed a
26 complex assortment of divisions, including 630-CITY, Animal Care and
27 Protective Services, Environmental Quality, Housing and Community
28 Development, Municipal Code Compliance, Mosquito Control,
29 Neighborhood Services, and the Office of Consumer Affairs; and

30 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Mosier was fortunate to find joy in his work, which
31 impacted the quality of his performance and the relationships he had

1 with his staff and with leadership. He felt privileged to do his
2 part for the city, and he valued each one of his co-workers. He was
3 truly proud of what his department did to help Jacksonville residents
4 every day; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Mosier was a devoted husband to his wife, Michele
6 Kay, and a doting father to his three girls, Katherine, Hannah and
7 Samantha. He adored his family and dearly loved his house of girls;
8 and

9 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Mosier was a man of strong spiritual faith, and he
10 and his family were congregants at Grace Community Church where he
11 also served for many years as a deacon and small group leader; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Bryan Mosier passed away December 10th after a
13 courageous battle with cancer, with his wife and daughters by his
14 side. He will be remembered as a dedicated public servant, husband,
15 father, son to Joe and Janice Mosier, brother to Deborah and Glenda
16 Jo, and as a colleague and friend who brightened the room with his
17 presence; now therefore

18 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1.** The City Council hereby honors Bryan Mosier's
20 years of service with great appreciation. Jacksonville City Council
21 extends heartfelt condolences to the Mosier family and friends upon
22 his passing, with the hope that his memory will provide comfort to
23 all those who had the honor to know him.
