RESOLUTION 2025-441-A

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH FLORIDA FOR ITS EXCEPTIONAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN WOMEN'S ATHLETICS AND RECOGNIZING THE STUDENT-ATHLETES, COACHES, AND STAFF FOR DEDICATION TO EXCELLENCE BOTH ON THE FIELD AND IN THE CLASSROOM; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the University of North Florida (UNF) demonstrated a steadfast commitment to the advancement of women's sports, fostering a culture of achievement, integrity, and academic excellence; and

WHEREAS, exemplifying the balance of academic and athletic excellence, UNF's women student-athletes have achieved a remarkable cumulative GPA of 3.58, including 90 percent of its student-athletes achieving at least a 3.0 GPA, and 42 earning a perfect 4.0; and

WHEREAS, the UNF Athletic Department won the Atlantic Sun (ASUN) Conference's 2024-25 President's Academic Cup, and the ASUN Conference's highest APR award was due to the academic success of its student-athletes; and

WHEREAS, during the most recent athletic season, UNF women's teams secured 3 team championships and 4 individual championships, showcasing their competitive spirit and elite performance; and

WHEREAS, reflecting the depth of talent and leadership across programs, 42 women student-athletes were named All-Conference, 4 earned Player of the Year honors, and 2 were recognized as ScholarAthletes of the Year; and

WHEREAS, setting new standards of excellence and inspiring future generations, 3 women student-athletes received 8 All-American selections, and 37 program records were broken; and

WHEREAS, softball standout, Allison Benning, earned many honors for both her pitching and hitting abilities, she was named ASUN Conference Scholar-Athlete of the Year, Pitcher of the Year, and Player of the Year; Ms. Benning was also named Mid-Major Player of the Year to go along with her All-American honors; and

WHEREAS, Zara Siassi became UNF's first All-American in Women's Soccer during the 2024 season, and was also named the ASUN Conference Defensive Player of the Year and Academic All-American; and

WHEREAS, Smilla Kolbe became UNF's first NCAA Indoor Track All-American when she finished 5th in the 800m at the National Championships, she was also named the ASUN Conference Scholar-Athlete of the Year and the ASUN Most Outstanding Track Performer of the Year; and

WHEREAS, Smilla Kolbe also finished 6th in the 800m run at the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Outdoor Track and Field Championship and has become the first UNF track and field athlete to earn first-time All-American honors; and

WHEREAS, these accomplishments bring pride to the City of Jacksonville and serve as a testament to the strength of collegiate athletics in our community; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City Council hereby commends and congratulates the University of North Florida for its extraordinary success in women's sports, encourages continued support for women's athletics, and celebrates the positive impact of these achievements on the broader Jacksonville community.
