## ORDINANCE 2022-581-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$3,038,585.00 FROM THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE GENERAL OPERATING FUND FUND BALANCE RECAPTURED FROM KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE ("KHA") FROM THE 2020-2021 FISCAL YEAR TO THE KHA OPERATING FUND OUT OF SCHOOL TIME, JUVENILE JUSTICE, EARLY LEARNING, SPECIAL NEEDS, GRIEF COUNSELING/BURIAL COSTS AND PRE-TEEN/TEEN CATEGORY ACCOUNTS FOR THE PROVISION OF CONTINUED ESSENTIAL SERVICES TO CHILDREN AND YOUTH IN DUVAL COUNTY THROUGH THE 2022-2023 FISCAL YEAR YEAR, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 22-100; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS TO FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023; AMENDING THE SECOND REVISED SCHEDULE ORDINANCE 2022-511-E; TO INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS), (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, REGARDING CHILDREN'S SERVICES PROGRAM CONTRACTS TO BE PROVIDED BY PROVIDERS SPECIFIED THIS TNORDINANCE; AUTHORIZING THEMAYOR, OR DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND/OR CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF KHA, EXECUTE AND DELIVER CHILDREN'S SERVICES CONTRACTS AND/OR AMENDMENTS THERETO, WITH PROVIDERS SPECIFIED IN THIS ORDINANCE; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 77.111(A) (PROVIDER CONTRACTS), CHAPTER
77 (KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO
EXEMPT THE AGREEMENTS AND AMENDMENTS SPECIFIED
IN THIS ORDINANCE FROM COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION;
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2021-2022 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above is an appropriation of \$3,038,585.00 from the City's General Operating Fund fund balance recaptured from fiscal year 2020-2021 close out of KHA operating funds to provide continued essential services to children and youth in Duval County through fiscal year 2022-2023. Funds appropriated hereby will be allocated to the Kids Hope Alliance ("KHA") Out of School Time, Juvenile Justice, Early Learning, Special Needs, Grief Counseling/Burial Costs and Pre-Teen/Teen essential services categories as outlined in Revised Exhibit 1.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to allocate funds from the City's General Operating Fund

fund balance recaptured from fiscal year 2020-2021 close out of KHA operating funds to provide continued essential services to children and youth in Duval County. A portion of these recaptured dollars will fund six-month extensions to 14 existing contracts with various current service providers that will expire on January 31, 2023. Extension of these contracts will allow these providers to continue offering services in various essential services categories through the 2022-2023 school year and summer (through July 31, 2023). addition, a portion of these funds will be allocated to the Juvenile Justice category for the diversion program, the Out of School Time category for afterschool and summer programming in 2022-2023, and the Pre-Teen/Teen, Learning, Special Needs, and Grief Counseling/Burial Costs essential services categories.

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Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated in this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2022-2023.

Section 4. Amending Second Revised Schedule M to Ordinance 2022-511-E. There is hereby amended for the fiscal year 2021-2022 budget for KHA by substituting in the place of the Second Revised Schedule M, approved by Ordinance 2021-672-E, the Third Revised Schedule M, attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Third Revised Schedule M reflects the funds appropriated herein.

Section 5. Invoking the exemption in Section 126.107(g), Ordinane Code. Kids Hope Alliance is hereby authorized to procure additional children's services from the providers listed and in the maximum amounts shown in Exhibit 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such services are exempted from competitive solicitation because the children's services to be provided by the

specified providers are being appropriated and approved in this authorizing legislation.

Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary, and/or the Chief Executive Officer of KHA are hereby authorized to execute new contracts, or amendments to existing contracts, with the children's services providers listed in **Exhibit 2**. These new contracts, or amendments to existing contracts as the case may be, will provide for a six-month extension for services currently being rendered by the listed providers through July 31, 2023, and an increase to the maximum indebtedness for each respective contract up to the amount listed in **Exhibit 2** to pay for additional services rendered by each provider during the six-month extension.

Section 7. Waiver of the provisions in Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts, Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), Ordinance Code.

The City hereby waives the provisions in Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), Ordinance Code, approved and authorized in Section 4 of this Ordinance. Section 77.111(a) requires contracts for children's services to be competitively procured by KHA via an evaluated bid process. The subject contracts were initially awarded via an evaluated bid process. However, a sixmonth extension to these contracts is needed so the providers may continue providing children's services through the end of the 2022-2023 school year and summer. This waiver is necessary in order to allow KHA to execute contracts, or amendments to existing contracts, with these providers without the need to competitively procure for the purposes of a six-month extension.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
