## RESOLUTION 2024-774

A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING MANDARIN UNITED METHODIST CHURCH ON THE OCCASION OF ITS 150TH ANNIVERSARY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Mandarin United Methodist Church, located at 11270 San Jose Boulevard, will be celebrating its 150th anniversary on November 17, 2024. Mandarin United Methodist Church is the second-oldest church in the Mandarin community and among the oldest congregations in Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, Mandarin United Methodist Church was formed in 1874 shortly after famous author Harriet Beecher Stowe settled nearby. The first pastor, T.W. Moore, rode by horseback to the first church site and would go on to establish the nearby Fruit Cove community before becoming the fourth President of Florida Southern College; and

WHEREAS, since 1960, the congregation has been housed in three Mandarin locations during its history - just south of its current location at San Jose Boulevard and Loretto Road; north of I-295 at the intersection of San Jose Boulevard and Old St. Augustine Road and at its current location, 11270 San Jose Boulevard. With this history, it is evident that Mandarin United Methodist Church has always been at the "heart" of the thriving Mandarin community. This congregation precedes the formation of the current United Methodist Church denomination in 1968 and the building of the essential Buckman Bridge across the neighboring St. Johns River in 1970; and

WHEREAS, the congregation meets at the 10-acre location and has had a membership of 3,000-plus for much of the last two decades. The church has been served by 57 pastors throughout its history and

has served the community with an assortment of activities that have been vital to Mandarin's identity, most prominently Upward Sports at its gymnasium and fields, the pumpkin patch each fall, crafts fair and Learning Ladders preschool; and

WHEREAS, Mandarin United Methodist Church's motto for the anniversary year is "150 Years and Our Story is Still Unfolding"; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City Council hereby honors and commends the congregation of Mandarin United Methodist Church on reaching the outstanding milestone of its 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary and congratulates the members on an exemplary history of faith and service. The Council extends best wishes to Pastor Britt Gilmore, Associate Pastor Missy Hart, Longleaf Pastor Kevin Griffin, and all the ministries and members of the church for many more decades of success.
