Type of Action: Approving revision of voting precinct boundaries and polling locations; request for emergency action on one committee cycle

Bill Summary: The bill approves revisions to several voting precinct boundaries and polling locations in Council Districts 10 and 11 at the request of the Supervisor of Elections. Emergency passage of the ordinance following one committee cycle is requested in order to expedite the notification of voters impacted by these changes before the Presidential preference primary election in March of 2024.

Background Information: The bill alters the precinct boundaries of precincts 1001, 1002 and 1006 in District 10 and relocates the polling place for district 1002 from Woodlawn Presbyterian Church on Woodlawn Road to St. Paul AME Church at 6910 New Kings Road. It also combines precincts 1103 and 1107 in District 11 into a new precinct 1107, the polling place for which will be at Covenant Christian Church at 10570 Greenville Road.

Policy Impact Area: Electoral precincts

Fiscal Impact: Anticipated to be minimal, primarily for printing and mailing of new voter information cards
