**Bill Summary:** The bill expresses the City Council's support for the application of Jacksonville's Eastside community for designation as an official Florida Main Street Community.

**Background Information:** The Florida Main Street Program is administered by the Florida Division of Historical Resources to assist Florida communities in developing public-private partnerships to revitalize historic business corridors identified as local "Main Streets". Jacksonville's historical Eastside community is making application to the program to have portions of A. Philip Randolph Boulevard and East Union Street declared as a recognized Florida Main Street. If the application is approved by the program, Eastside would become the first Florida Main Street designated neighborhood in Jacksonville.
