## RESOLUTION 2024-967-A

A RESOLUTION CELEBRATING NOVEMBER 23, 2024, AS NATIONAL ADOPTION DAY IN JACKSONVILLE AND RECOGNIZING THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER AS NATIONAL ADOPTION MONTH; REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in more than 400 communities across the country, courts have opened their doors on or around the Saturday before Thanksgiving for "National Adoption Day" to finalize and celebrate adoptions while simultaneously recognizing this day as an opportunity to raise awareness of the children in foster care waiting to be adopted; and

WHEREAS, since 1995, November has been known as National Adoption Month, with a focus upon the adoption of children currently in foster care, and an opportunity to honor adoptive families who chose to provide children with a permanent place to call home; and

WHEREAS, nationwide more than 100,000 children are waiting to be adopted, and in Florida in 2022, more than 8,000 children in foster care awaited adoption and 3,800 children were adopted; and

WHEREAS, one in every thirty-five children in the United States is adopted, and the act of adoption is life-changing, for children, parents, and extended families and friends; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City Council hereby celebrates November 23,

a special opportunity to acknowledge the creation of new and growing families on the Saturday before Thanksgiving. The City Council also celebrates November as National Adoption Month, creating an opportunity to spread awareness about adoption, advocate for the wellbeing of children in foster care, and to honor families that have given children a permanent place to call home.

Section 2. Requesting Emergency Passage Upon Introduction
