Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funds for the demolition, removal, remediation, and replacement of both sections of the elevator/pit system in the Moran Theatre.

CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2019-505-E, Section 3. the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide funding for the project entitled "Performing Arts Center -Performing Arts Center - Building Systems." The project is more fully described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will result in unnecessary further delay in this needed improvement. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2016-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2016-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
