**Bill Summary:** This bill is an appropriation of \$100,974 from the Social Justice and Community Investment Special Committee Contingency and to be utilized by the Jacksonville Public Education Fund, Inc. for the 5000 Role Models of Excellence project. The bill amends the Third Revised Schedule M to Ordinance 2020-511-E to reflect additional transfers and funds appropriated. The funding agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Jacksonville Public Education Fund, Inc. (JPEF) is authorized, and the exception to Section 126.107(g) is invoked to procure the services of JPEF.

The requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), *Ordinance Code*, for children's services to be competitively procured by KHA via an evaluated bid process are waived. Section 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition against), Part 1 (The City Treasury), Chapter 110 (City Treasury), *Ordinance Code*, is waived to allow for a partial advance payment. The Kids Hope Alliance will oversee the project.

**Background Information:** The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for the 5000 Role Models of Excellence project, for uniforms and transportation. 5000 Role Models of Excellence serves young minority male students and offers positive visions of success through positive adult role models, mentorship and exposure. This program was selected for potential funding through the Special Committee on Social Justice and Community Investment jobs initiatives selection process.
