6 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF  
7 KIMBERLY PADGETT MORRISON, A DUVAL COUNTY  
8 RESIDENT, AS A MEMBER OF THE CULTURAL SERVICE  
9 GRANT PROGRAM COMMITTEE, AS ONE OF THE SEVEN  
10 COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES, PURSUANT TO SECTION  
11 118.605, *ORDINANCE CODE*, FOR A FIRST FULL TERM  
12 EXPIRING DECEMBER 31, 2027; PROVIDING AN  
13 EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 118.605(a), *Ordinance Code*, the  
16 membership of the Cultural Service Grant Program (CSGP) Committee  
17 shall include one non-voting and ten voting members: a CSGP Committee  
18 chairperson (non-voting), appointed by the President of the Cultural  
19 Council Board of Directors; three other Cultural Council Board members  
20 selected by the Board President and Committee Chairperson; and seven  
21 individuals selected by the above group (Cultural Council Board  
22 President, CSGP Committee chairperson, and three selected Cultural  
23 Council Board members) from a pool of nominations established through  
24 a community wide nomination process; and

25 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 118.605(d), *Ordinance Code*, all  
26 members of the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee shall be  
27 confirmed by the City Council; and

28 **WHEREAS**, Kimberly Padgett Morrison was appointed to the  
29 Cultural Service Grant Program Committee pursuant to Resolution 2024-  
30 586-A for a partial term ending December 31, 2024; now therefore

31 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

1           **Section 1.           Reappointment.** The Council hereby confirms the  
2 reappointment of Kimberly Padgett Morrison, a Duval County resident,  
3 to the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee, as one of seven  
4 community representatives, pursuant to Section 118.605, *Ordinance*  
5 *Code*, for a first full term expiring December 31, 2027.

6           **Section 2.           Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become  
7 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
8 without the Mayor's signature.
